As in 2022 UNESCO reported that globalization exposes children to conflicting cultural values, often at odds with parental expectations. As they might adopt new behaviors, social practices or communication styles encountered through media, peers or schooling, which may clash with traditional ethical standards. It is very important to balance freedom to protect cultural values, norms and traditions.

The use of secularism and atheistic thought among children has emerged as another

challenge for parents. West is moving towards undermining religious influence and values which is affecting ethical and moral conduct among youth making it challenging for parents to hold responsibility. Pew Research center reported in 2020 that increasing number of youth identifying as non-religious, reflecting a broader global trend toward secularization. Although intellectual thoughts and freedom are leading towards positivism but it is parental responsibility to combat religious decline by adopting traditional practices.

Modern parenting is further complicated by increased exposure of children to social evils, violence and risky behaviours.
