2. Difference between new provinces and local government system

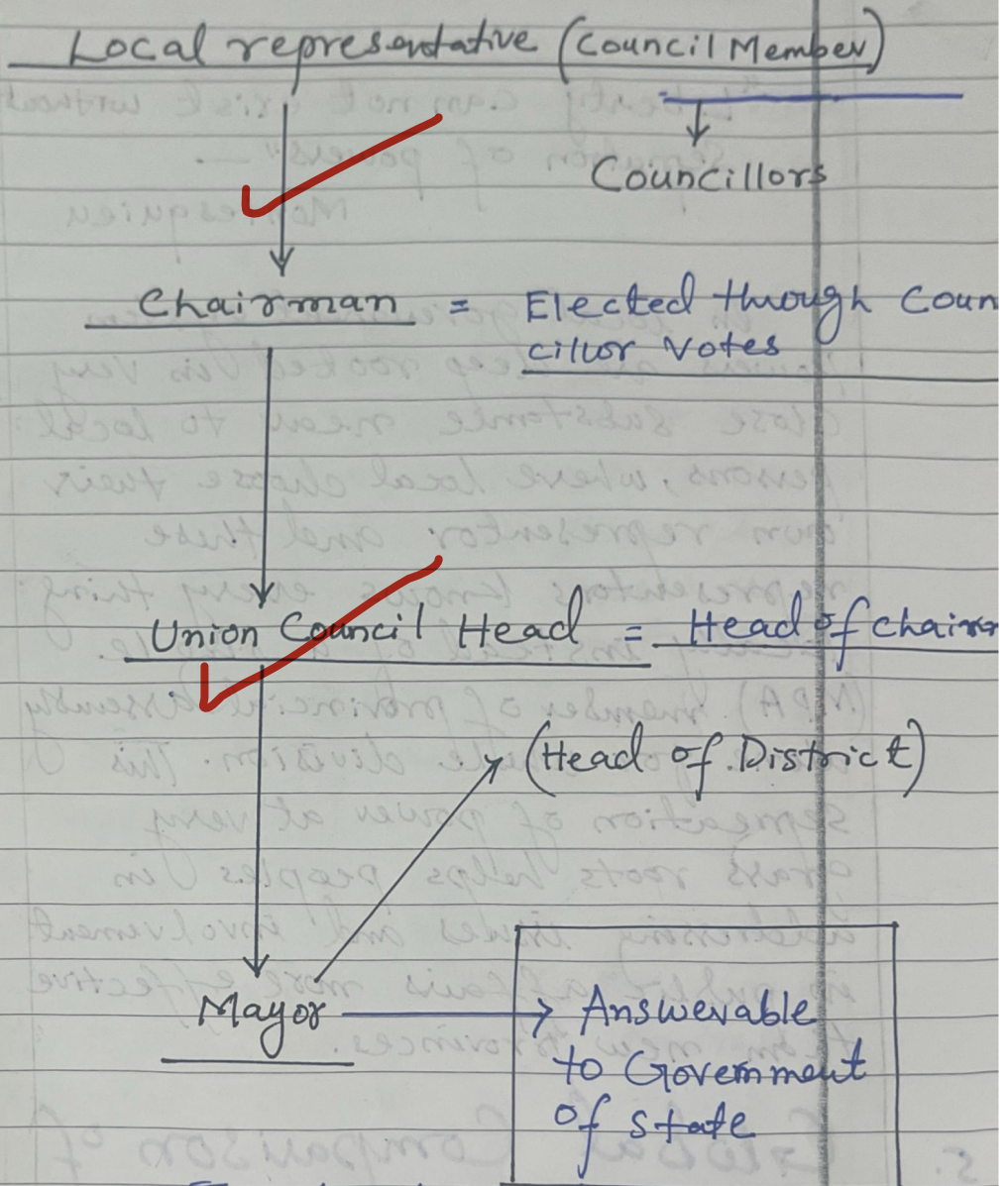

2. Framework of 27th Amendment:-

The 27th Amendment contains new themes and structure which are described as:

9) Announced new Military office

The amendment creates a new office of (CDF) Chief of Defence Forces by withdrawing the office of (JCOA) Joint Chairmen of Armed Forces.

i) Global Contrast on this Amendment

Globally, ~~specific~~ it is contrasted with neighbours of Pakistan. The office of only dominant leader of Armed forces introduced by Pakistan only. On the other hand powerful countries like Turkey, Iran, and North Korea have single controlled leader of Armed Forces.

b) New Federal Constitutional Court
