non-malicious ad hominem in a jury trial by highlighting

his opponent backward-buttoned shirt to sway the jury,

despite being outmanned on legal points. The fallacy has

ancient roots, likely used by the sophists. Historical

Political examples include attack on presidents Eisenhower and Roosevelt, where opponents targeted the individuals rather than policies, illustrating a harmful form of ad-hominem.
