The Ad Hominem Fallacy: Attacking the Person, Not the Argument

The author explained the example of Ad Hominem fallacy where a young lawyer Lincoln used this. When he did not have legal points to win the case, he attacked on the personality of the senior opponent lawyer, who buttoned his shirt back. He asserted that, "The man who does not even know which side of his shirt ought to be in front, how can he influence the judge". The use of ad hominem by Lincoln won him the case. Sometimes this fallacy is an important consideration like considering the health of president in the nominations, but sometimes it becomes vicious like rejecting the policy because it has crippled in the white house.

Although ad hominem arguments have existed since ancient times, they become particularly harmful when used viciously—as seen in personal attacks on figures like President Franklin Roosevelt. Such tactics divert attention from substantive issues to irrelevant personal traits.
