On **December 20, 1943**, American pilot **Charles Brown's B-17** was damaged by German fighters (**He was severely**). Ace pilot **Frank Stigler** saw the helpless plane. He restrained to shot it down and recalling his Commander's warning "If you ever shoot at an **enemy** in a parachute, I will shoot you myself." **Fourty Years** latter, both pilots reunited and their friendship lasted until death.

The Story suggests about the meaning of true bravery beyond fighting as a true warrior maintaining humanity and ethics even on the battlefield. If the soldiers had ignored their Conscience, countless innocent lives would have been lost. But if they had upheld courage alongside morality, their actions would not only inspire generations but also preserve the dignity of war itself.

Indian Field Marshal Sam Manekshaw requested to award Captain Ihsan Malik during ¹⁹⁷¹ World, due to his extraordinary bravery. Similarly, during Iran-Iraq war, a volunteer Zahid Haftlang risked his life to save Nazia Abud, a soldier in the Iraqi army. Eighteen years later they met unexpectedly and laughed, cried and embrace. They prove life long bonds even across enemy lines.

In the same way, story of American pilot Charles Brown and German fighter Franz's inspiring story exist from a long ago.
