Introduction

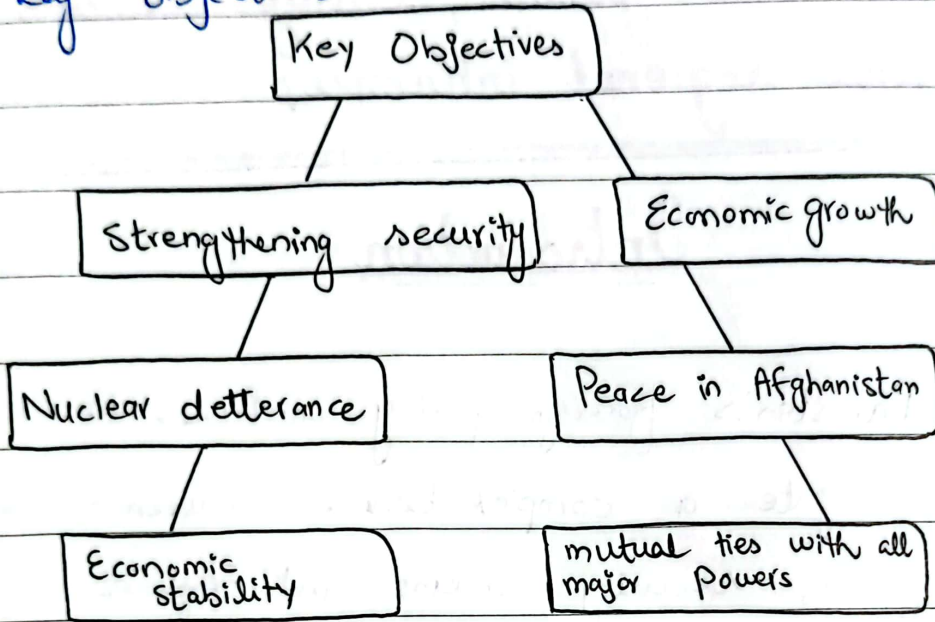

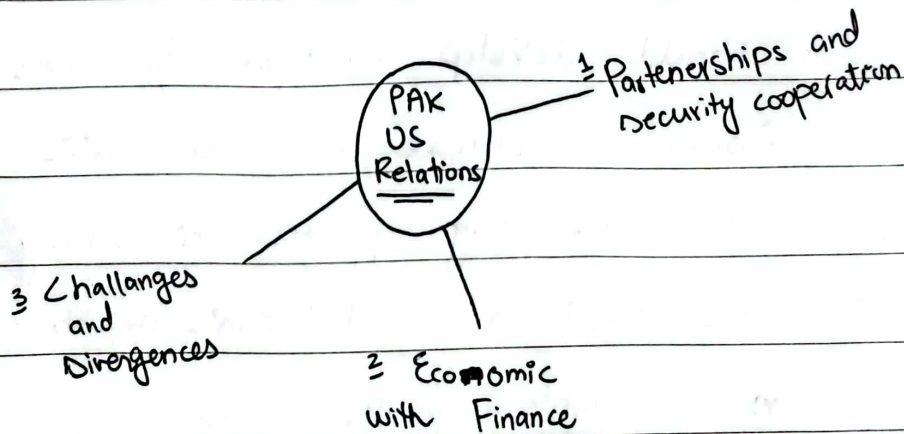
Foreign policy of Pakistan

Pakistan relations with USA

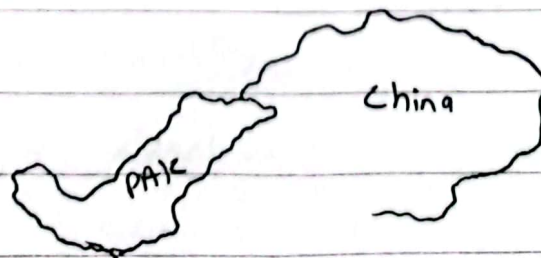

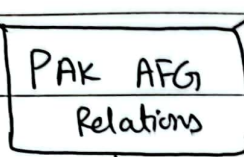
