A. Political instability across the country

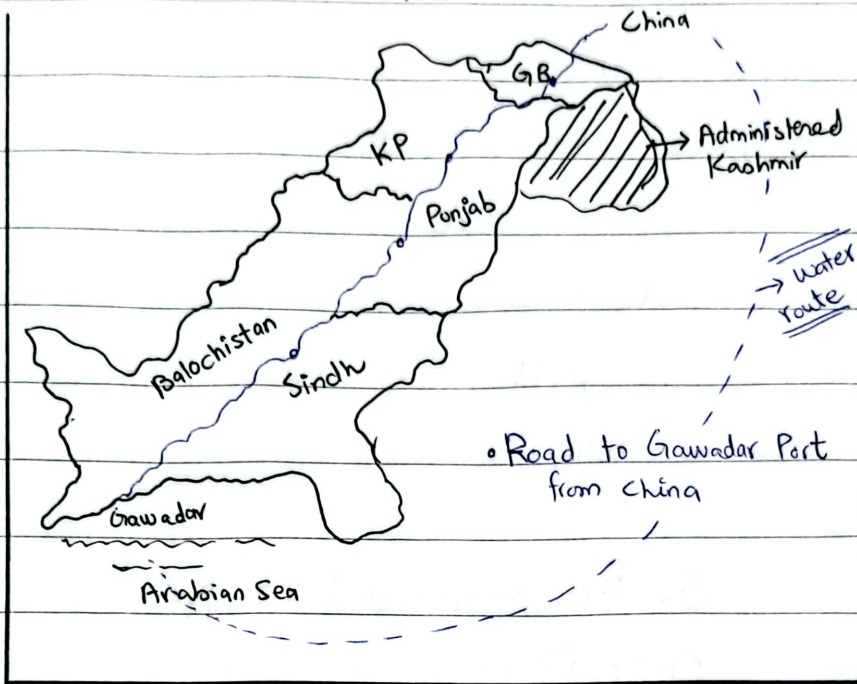

A- Political stability in Pakistan

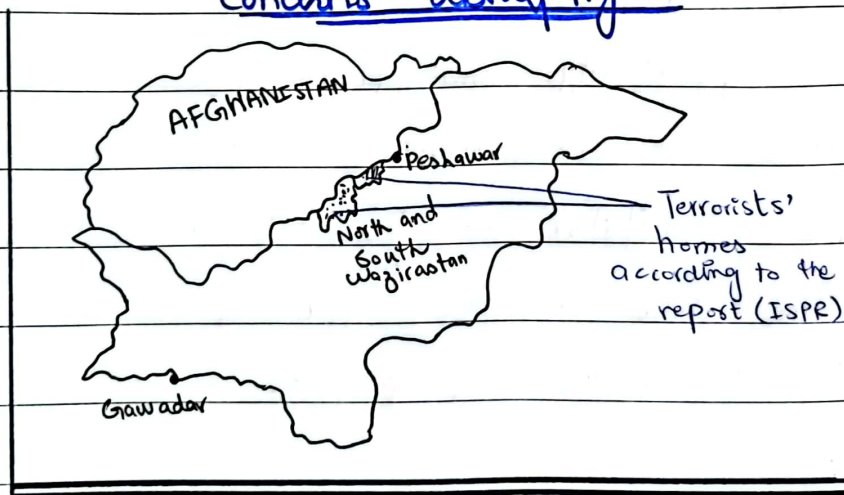

This is the factor, Afghan Taliban have given homes to TTP. That is a biggest threat for Pakistan regarding security.

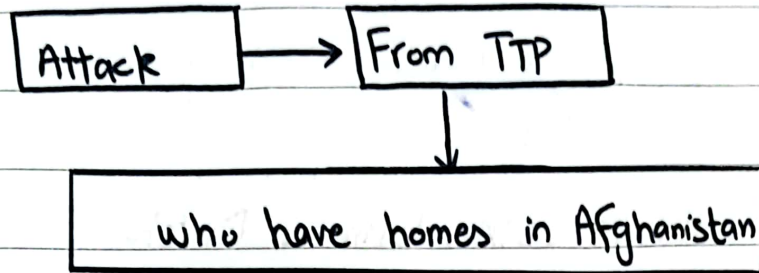
(B) Reasons, why Pakistan attacked in Afghanistan recently

This thing also indicates that Pakistan is being warned. It also has created

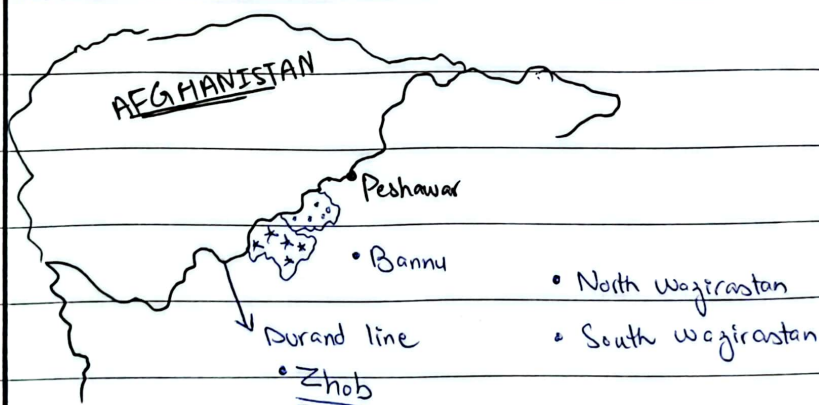
more tensions between both countries
