Explain in the detail Muslims.

Introduction:

Treaty of Hudaibiya done at 2- Hijri, when the Quraysh of Mecca and Muslims of Madina appeared in conflict mode. Hazrat Muhammad S.A.W at that time used his diplomatic skills and signed an agreement between both parties and took signature on various aspects i.e. protection of lives and property, freedom of movement, by accepting hostilities, patience and tolerance.

Treaty of Hudaibiya as Game Changer:-

According to the Quran, Allah has given you a conquest and open the paths for the muslims according to His way.

This verse of Surah Al-Fatih acknowledged the diplomatic winning of muslims. It can be demonstrated by the various agreements:-

(i) Establishment of Truce:-

Prophet Muhammad S.A.W bound an agreement upon both Medina muslims and Quraysh that not to fight with each other and maintain a peace agreement. And this agreement signed for about ten years, that these both parties cannot fight for ten years.

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and also tried to expand this duration
for the peace and prevention of human
loss.

Freedom of movement:

"Both parties has freedom of
choice"

Prophet Muhammad S.A.W as diplomat
set the idea that both tribes have their
own cultures and followings, they
both have freedom to do whatever
they want and don't interfere in
one another's matters.

Accepts Hostilities:

Some sanctions aligned by Quraysh
on Madina muslims i.e Not to do
Umrah at specific year. Prophet
Muhammad S.A.W accepted this hostility
and advised for the peaceful
environment. This would make a
sound environment and circumstances
between Meva Quraysh and
Madina muslims.

Negotiations over conflict:

Quraysh did not allow
muslims to do Umrah. This makes
no comfort for muslims but Harat
Muhammad S.A.W stayed cool and
accept their hostility and advised

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muslims to keep calm.

Protection of Lives and Property:

People of madina and Quraysh
signed an agreement that they will
protect each other's lives and property.
If third party attacked on them, they
should collaborate with each other
inspite of religious affiliation. This
makes to create nationalism between
the community and felt relaxed that
they are free to live like they want
and it can enhanced their security
concerns also.

Patience Immense:

By the diplomatic behaviour of
Prophet Muhammad S.A.W during Treaty
of Hudaibiyyah, it is clear to the muslims
that patience can safeguard the Islamic
culture and prestige. Patience results
in marginalized conflicts and
develop a thoughtful and cool
behaviour which cannot be harmful
and stampful for the rest of the
people in the region.

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According to Quran;

Those who can follow you, follow the alligence of Allah and the hand of Allah is above their hands.

This verse can emphasize on the seriousness of this treaty - Allah is the one who make the circumstances to give an example to the future muslims in the form of Sunnah of so that they can follow the same way as Allah recommended -

Prophet Muhammad S.A.W bear all the behavoirs of Quraish patiently - He said that I am the one who bear the extreme stress from all of you -

Prevention of escalation:

While treaty was designed to prevent escalation and included mechanism if someone breaches the treaty of Hudaybiyah. When the Quraish violated the treaty by attacking the other tribe in an attack or tribe allied with muslims - The treaty stipulated prevented hostilities caused by it.

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Conclusion:

Hur, Treaty of Hudaybiyah is an remarkable event about passing harmony and peace among the humans by the actions of Prophet Muhammad S.A.W as diplomat.

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Short note on:

→ Equality in Islam :-

Islam can preach the equality of mankind. According to Hadlees, Arab is not superior on non-Arab. Nor non-Arab superior on Arab as well as Black is not superior on white and white not superior on man. Every one is equal for Allah.

Furthermore in Islam, there despite of human equality in caste, creed, race and color; Islam also referrs to no gender disparity. According to Quran, women has some rights on man as the man rights over women - At one place in Quran, Allah said that O man, Allah has been created You from male and female and keep you in tribes and nations so that you should know one another.

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and interact with each other. Thus Islam as a religion promotes peace, brotherhood, cooperation, relevance as well as equality in all institutions i.e. education, creed, caste, colour, and health etc.

According to Hadith:-

"Everyone should not seek knowledge."

(b) The beauty of Islamic culture:

Islam is the religion which can propagate in the society and cause harmony, peace and reconciliation. These all cultural aspects can be seen through social, justice, political and administrative as well as diplomatic stance of Islam. This can bring affiliation, harmony, coordination, peace, brotherhood, economic efficiency, political stability, social integration between individuals, communities and states. Islamic culture

As in Quran Allah said that:

'Allah equipped man as his parent. Mother carried his child in weakness of weakness so that respect of Me and your parents. As Allah rewarded you with the best.'

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At one place Allah in Quran, Allah emphasizes on unity and harmony between the humans. O man, we created you from man and woman and made you in tribes and nations so you should know each other. Marriage in Islam creates the soothing and sincere effect for both man and woman. In Quran Allah said that we created you in pairs, and so that you gain peace from each other. Zakat, Salat, Ramadhan, Hajj can create a season of life. In Quran Allah said From you one is best, who earn by himself. At another place Allah wants to emphasize to attempt Salat so that a muslim can forgive him to his wife and sunnah will be in his favour. As the beauty of Islamic culture is persistent and valuable from any other religion.

Rule of law :-

Islam can promote justice and fairness by emphasizing on transparent rule of law for all members and others.

In Quran Allah said that, Allah commands you to treat those,

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whom, He is alive and when there
is division between the people do
justice fairly-

So, by the verse it is clear that
Islam only preaches fair and just
divisions among people.

At one place in Hadis, It is demonstrated
that, the one from you is closer
to Allah who is best to the people.

In Islam man also advised to
fair with their wives and family.
According to Hadis, the one is best
from you who is best with his
wives and I am bestest among you -

promotes the diplomatic talks.
According to Hadis, that who kills a
soul for conflict on land, slays entire
humanity and who saves one, will
save entire humanity.

Question no:

Analyze the last sermon of Prophet SAW
as comprehensive charter of Human
Rights:

Introduction:

Last sermon of Prophet also called as
Hijrat-ul-Kudab. At this sermon, Prophet
Muhammad S.A.W advised and visualized
muslim community about importance
of human rights with an individuals
men and women community and
States. It can be analyzed in parameters
i.e. equality of human beings, protection
of rights, justice and accountability and
respect for diversity and tolerance.

Key Elements of The last Sermon
as a Charter of Human Rights:

(i) Equality of All Human Beings:-

Text of Sermon:-

Neither Arab has Superiority over
non-Arab nor non-Arab has superiority

our Arab, our Black is not superior to white and someone white is not superior to Black or all humans are equal from Allah.

Analyse: Muin, this text analytically demonstrated that if undemocratic circumstances of that time, when people recognized on the basis of their cast, colour and creed. Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) advised that all are equal and no one is superior over the other.

(iii) Sanctity of wife and Protection of Rights:

Text of sermon: Your property, your blood and your belongings are inviolable until you meet the Lord, as just His day. This month and this place is sacred.

(iv) Justice and Accountability:

Text of sermon: Do not revert towards me, after me by striking necks with one another.

Analyse: According to Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) the property, wife and belongings of an individual is inviolable. This is the fundamental human right now globally. No one has right to justify and harm your wife and belongings taken from. This can show the sanctity of wife and protection of rights.

(v) Women Rights:

Text of sermon: Women have same rights over men and men has rights over women so that men should treat women kindly and they are their created by prophet.

Analyse: This makes visualize the gender imbalance of men and women but, each other they live and completed without each other. The rights of man is equal to the rights of woman and women are so that men did not subject them to violence and become kinder to them.

Text of sermon: Do not revert towards me, after me by striking necks with one another.

Analyse: This text reflects that Islam always propagates fairness and justice among people. And Hazrat Muhammad S.A.W advised to be with one another unitedly and face challenges together. Avoid disputes and conflicts among one another and be in peace and harmony.

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(v) Economic Justice:

Sermon text says God is the One giving women, Verily, you have taken them as trust from God and have enjoyment of this book by word of Allah.

Analyze: Prophet Muhammad S.A.W advised muslims to take care in the matters about women. And when do marriage gave their equal rights as in Kaafir-meek as well as they are dependent on you so be the provider of your women and your family.

(vi) Respect for Diversity and Tolerance:

last Sermon text :-

I completed Deen over you, and left two things to you, Quran and Sunnah.

Analyze: This reference to Quran and Sunnah emphasizes the importance of upholding moral and ethical values that guide interactions between people, regardless of their belief.

It is concluded that Prophet Muhammad S.A.W in his last sermon promotes fundamental human rights and
