In today's fast moving world, everyone is undergoing multitasking all the times. To do so much in very less time is the norm being practiced in today's world. Multitasking, adopting quicker shorter ways are promoted to perform and complete more tasks. But performing any task, act or service quickly without completely comprehending it has its own negative impacts.

The repercussions are far-reaching from poor quality of the task or service, ^{to} repetition required to repair the damages that leads to greater consumption of time than expected or previously originally spent on the task. Services that are performed with haste can clearly be differentiated from the ones performed with ease, due to the difference in quality of the tasks. As these services and products lack quality assurance as they undergo short and quick (supply chain) methods to complete. Thus leading to poor quality product and service. This severely damages the company's or person's reputation and future expectations. So, haste makes a lot of damage (for the one) in terms of wasted time, energy and no utilization of product or service.

Furthermore, (the concept of) adopting haste in performing any act in life leads to a damaged product or service and

wastage of time, energy and resources as it lacks critical thinking. When a service is performed or a task is completed or a question is solved without undergoing in-depth analysis and thorough critical thinking, it lacks depth. A critical analysis that can improve the quality of the tasks and covers all aspects of the service/product or task: lacking this in performing any act severely damages the product quality.
