
Har Gibb says that Islam

Contextual meaning: "Subjugate before Allah"
Quran itself tells the importance of prayer by repeating 700 times. Allah asks muslim to be steadfast in prayer as it

gives physical, psychological and spiritual relief. Prayer keeps muslim away from evil and bad deeds and encourages good. Prayer also bring social, moral and spiritual reforms. It keep muslim accountable in front of Allah and make strong bond with Allah. Prayer also enhances bonds with humanity.

Importance Of Prayer In Quran.

IMPORTANCE OF PRAYER ACCORDING TO RELIGIOUS SCHOLAR.

Offering prayer is one of the most important aspect of Islam and there is no leniency to deny its offering. At one place it is claimed that once a person asked the importance of prayer from Prophet (PBUH) and he replied
Contentual meaning

"Offer namaz in a proper way or on chair or at bed either in standing

sitting or lying position respectively. ”

Importance of Prayer in Islam

Prayer is a mandatory worship in Islam. It is advised to offer the namaz in every situation of life. One Evidence displaying the importance of namaz is

“ Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) and his companions offered namaz in the battle field while fighting with the opponents in a division of two groups. One group offered namaz, while the other was fighting.”

CATEGORIES OF PRAYER

FARZ Namaz

This namaz it is made

obligatory in Islam. It is different for all five namaz. For Fajr it is 2 rakats, Zohar 4 rakats, Asar 4 rakats, Maghrib 3 rakats and for Isha its 4 rakats. It is the most rewarded category of Prayer.

Sunnat Namaz:

It has also different number of rakats for different prayers and rewarded accordingly. It should also be offered with Farz namaz except few exceptions. It can be forbid during travel or moving out of city for 15 days.

Nafal Namaz:

It is not obligatory and offered for specific reasons including rewards, desire or mannat etc.

Namaz Of Different Events.

Islam has assigned muslims few other forms of namaz for special occasions like Eid-ul-fitr and Eid-ul-Adha, Chasht namaz etc. There is a separate namaz for funeral named as Namaz-e-Janaza. It is the only namaz which do not bow.

Q3 STATUS OF WOMEN IN ISLAM

But after the birth of Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH), women got the dignity, she deserved, like every other male. Quran has emphasized multiple times on the women rights. Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) respected women irrespective of their religion and asked every sane men to respect her. IMPORTANCE AND SPECIFICATION

OF WOMEN RIGHTS

In Islam

1 Rights of women as a Mother

"If I am offering farz namaz and I would have called by my mother, I swear to Allah, I would have broken my prayer."

Hzrat Muhammad (PBUH).

Hzrat Muhammad (PBUH) by

explaining the importance of women as mother, tells the rights that she is more prestigious than namaz, so women should get the rights she deserved.

2 a) Rights of Women as a Daughter in Inheritance

Islam has given all rights to women as a daughter. Islam has given inheritance right to daughter by half the rights of men. For instance if men/son gets 2 parts of property daughter we get 1.

b) Inheritance Right of wife.

Wife is awarded $\frac{1}{8}$ th part of husband ~~property~~ profits and it is mentioned in Islam that if a man dies living behind wife and children (1 or many), First

the wife will get its share & then the remaining will be divided in children. If he has no child the wife gets $\frac{1}{4}$ th part.

c) Share as a Mother

If a man / son dies before his mother and mother will get $\frac{1}{6}$ th part of his property

3 Women Rights to Education in Islam

"Education is Obligatory for men and women in Islam."

Hadith.

4 Rights of Job and business to Women

"Harrat Khadija was a merchant after her deceased father and"

owned his trading business and run"

A saying by Hazrat Muhammad(PBUH)

b) Right to women to do job.

"Hazrat Umar (R.A)
hired Umme-Kulsoom
as a tax collector
in madina . "

c) Female allowed to teach in Islam

"Hazrat Ayesha (R.A)
was a religious scholar
and taught for more
than 50 years and
created 80 scholars
of her time."

Sahih-Muslim

6) Right to Participate in Battles.

Females were allowed to serve in battle for medical help and for providing food and water to warriors.

"Hazrat Ayesha (R.A) led the army against Hazrat Ali (R.A) and fought with a group of 11,000 soldiers, against Hazrat Uthman (R.A)."'

7) Rights given by Islam in Marriage

It is obligatory for women that her permission and consent should be taken before marriage, otherwise marriage is illegal and it is forbidden.

"Women should also verbally respond 3 times in acceptance"

Hadith.

8) Women Rights in Testimony.

Women is awarded to give testimony in financial matters. In Islam, as women are less aware of financial matters than men so, 2 women counts equal to 1 men for testimony.

a) Rights to women in equality to men in Crime

Women are men are equal in crime in Islam. Women has no relaxation in punishment except few acceptance like wise she is pregnant.

10) Rights at death.

Women should be wrapped by female only in 5 sheets and her body should be completely covered. Men are wrapped in 3 sheets but women got 2 more sheets to preserve her dignity even during death ritually.

"Hazrat Ayesha (RA) being awared of her death time, asked her servant that 'I would take death bath and wrap myself, so no-one could see me and take my Janaza at night so no men could see me'."

Conclusion

Islam has given all the rights of women to live a happy free and prosperous life. Islam gives rights from birth to death, in domestic and professional life from getting education to teach and fight in battles. Islam gives rights in inheritance separately defining every relation.

FEATURES OF SOCIAL JUSTICE

brotherhood

but one brotherhood
and mankind." "

Social justice enhances equality among all individuals in terms of fundamental rights irrespective of their caste, religion, sects or ethnicity and status

- 3) Islam's Social Justice ends class systems

"In Hindus, they have divided humans among four categories, Brahmins, Kshatriya, Vaish and Sudras - from top to bottom. Islam exhibits in equality only." Research

Hindus consider Brahmins as heads being genius, Kshatriyas as shoulders being warriors, Vaish as abdomen/stomach being farmers and Shudras as feet being the labourers, the cheap status. But Islam does not exhibits this class system and inhibits this.

4) Social Justice of Islam shows tolerance with non-muslims

"Tolerance is the defining character of Islam."

Former PM of UK
Tony Blair

Even non-muslims gives testimony about Islam's social justice. It do justice by behaving good with non-minorities and giving them right to live their religion freely without harming another religion or person like Christianism, etc.

5) Islam Promotes Peaceful Co-existence with all

" You all are from Adam and Eve. Neither Arab is superior to non-Arab nor non-Arab is superior to Arab. Neither white is superior to black nor black is superior to white. Except the one with pity is close to Allah."

Al-Quran.

Islam only promotes peaceful co-existence without discriminating with others on the base of their territory or class.

6) Islam Social justice supports meritocracy

" Get up Bilal! Call again and make us relax."

HADITH

Hazrat Muhammad (PBUH) supported meritocracy and hier Hazrat Bilal habsha (RA) as moazin irrespective of his colour and also showed muslims that merit does not discriminate anyone
