"All the believers are brothers so reclaim between your brothers and remain conscious of Allah so that you may receive mercy" (Al-Quran)

Islam prohibits the gender discrimination. Both the male and female have separate rights and responsibilities. Both play an important role in shaping the family as well as the society or community.

Promotion of welfare:

a- Personal responsibility:

"Those who do not have knowledge and those who have are not equal"

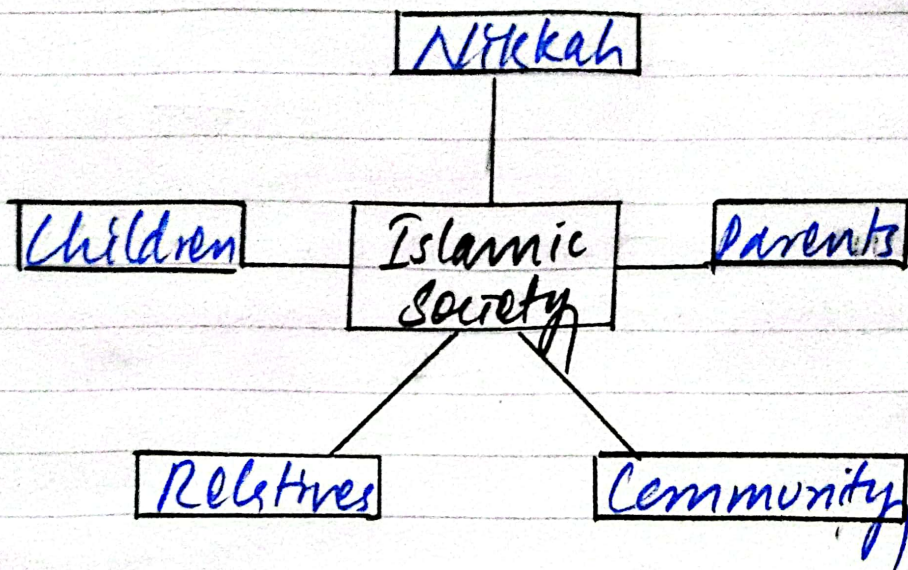
(Al-Quran)
