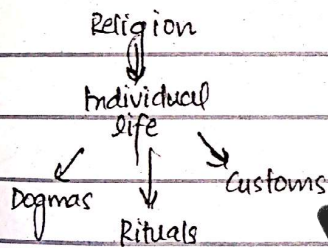

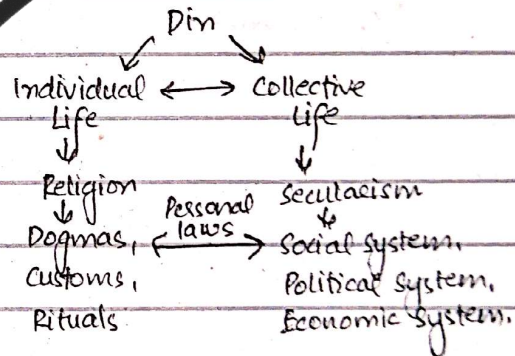

Importance of Din in human life:

Din being the complete code of life guides human in every aspect of life. Din is given to follow if reward at the end and peace here in this life is required.

1. Guidance to mankind

Doctrine of life is given by Allah for the guidance of mankind. Man has the need to be guided otherwise he might get astray and will lose the original path to follow. Din plays its role in mediation between the man and Allah where Allah has sent down his commandments. These commandments guide man about the right and wrong and guides man. As in case of Prophet Adam (A.S.), Allah through his commandments told him to follow the right path and not get astray. In Quran, it is clearly said that Din is guidance sent towards mankind in the form of Quran - The Holy Book of Allah.

2. Clear Path Provision

Almighty Allah through his Din has provided not only Muslims but the whole mankind a clear path to follow. Obedience of Allah and His Prophet (PBUH) promises a better successful future in this life and the hereafter. Mankind have been told about 'salat' in Quran as it a path which leads man towards Allah and prevents him from going towards any sin be it major or minor. The commandments and the clear path produces fear of Allah, piety, gratefulness, sincerity and honesty within the hearts of man. All of these values within a man prevents him to follow the excess of Satan rather encourages to follow clear path provided by Almighty Allah.

(Hadith)

3. From darkness to light

In Quran Allah says,

(Al-Hamid)

It clearly asserts that Din is sent down upon mankind and servants of Allah to show mankind the clear and straight path through His light of guidance. This light of guidance prevents Muslims to indulge in any wrongful acts. Allah's light of guidance is one thing that Prophet Muhammad (P.B.U.T) told mankind to hold onto tightly and only this can lead them to ~~the~~ the reward of Hereafter.

4. Din as source of wisdom

In Surah Ya-Sin of Quran, Allah says:

يايسين ۝ والقرآن الحكيم ۝

Ya-Sin. By the Quran rich in wisdom.

(Ya-Sin)

Din is also a source of wisdom. In any issue of socio-political-economic culture of man today, Quran is a source of guidance. It consists of wisdom which can be used to solve any modern day problem. Din also has the concept of Ijtihad which ~~states~~ solves issues through modern day solutions. For example, the issue of Palestine if to be solved through Islamic and teachings of Din, Ijtihad and Quran are the ultimate solutions.

5. Din as path of choice

Din advocates free will and choice and is in way a tool to be used to force an individual

to accept Islam and follow the teachings of Din. Allah even commanded His Prophets to preach Din and not force anyone to accept it. In today's ~~world~~ Pakistan, a number of majorities exist including Hindus and Christians. In Sindh, the young ^{girls of} minorities are converted forcefully and made to marry some ~~landlord~~ forcefully. It is not only a violation of teaching of Din but that of human rights. For the forceful conversion, Allah Almighty says,

لا إكراه في الدين

"Let there be no compulsion in religion." (Al-Baqarah)

Din as complete code of life

Din has teachings from all contexts of life and for all mankind on Earth. Its limitation to only Muslims is negated by Allah. He even sent the Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) for all mankind to follow as an example. The major issues of the world today including the Middle East Crisis can be solved by taking an example of Prophet (PBUH) for how he managed to establish cordial relations between tribes of Medina, Bano Qurayza and Bano Muslims there. All of the measures he took to resolve the problem were directly following Allah's commandments. So Din can be used by all mankind to evade any modern day issue.

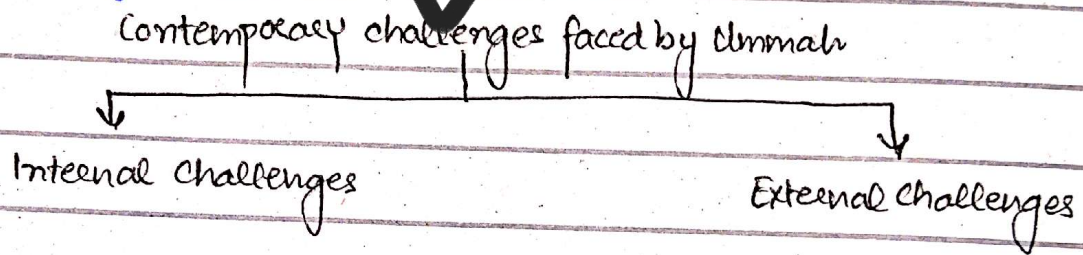

Muslim Ummah losing front seat:

This chunk of population has started ^{to face} their downfall because of intellectual stagnation, lack in advancement of technology and domination of the West. Muslim Ummah faces severe challenges from within along with external factors which has altogether become a hurdle in the progression of Muslim society in the world.

Challenges faced by Muslim Ummah:



a. Internal contemporary challenges faced by Muslim Ummah:

① Intellectual Stagnation

Muslim Ummah is facing problems in the modern age not due to the religious issues rather intellectual stagnation. Muslim Ummah has forgot their golden era of achievements of Muslim scientists Al-Khawarizmi and Al-Beruni etc rather they have adopted Western way of life. Western political, economic and social system has brought a drift between the sovereign Muslim states and they are not on the road of progress altogether like their

glorious past.

② Exploitation of resources

Muslim Ummah is blessed with major resources including natural gas, oil, copper, jute, cotton and many other resources. World even in this modern age when talk of renewables make around 45% of energy from the oil and natural gas and Muslim world is unable to exploit these resources. They see towards the West to take benefit of their resources in exchange for their dollars. e.g. Saudi Arabia a major exporter of petrol and oil looks towards US for exploitation of its resources.

③ Lack in advancement of science and technology

Muslim Ummah has a golden history of being the father of many sciences and today it has lost all of its desire, passion and drive to excel in different emerging fields. We have failed to produce notable Nobel Prize winners. We lack in establishing universities and education centres of world class recognition. Only 2 to 3 countries of Pakistan comes above 500 in world ranking of universities. Turkey however is striving to promote itself in this field.

④ Importance of Materialism over Moral Values

Muslim Ummah today runs for the power. Power strife has made the countries forget about moral values Islam had taught us. Leaders of these 57 sovereign states run for power and they will do everything even if it requires killing of individuals. Palestine is not highlighted by Muslim Ummah today because of their cordial relations with the Western superpower to go for power and play in world affairs all alone.

⑤ Extremism and Terrorism within the Muslim countries

Muslim countries after 9/11 have faced the Western side labelling of ~~them~~ Muslims being terrorists and extremists. This has given rise to their concept of Islamophobia. This labelling by West has been conceived by the whole world and has made Muslim Ummah an extremist community. Muslim leaders have failed to take a stance against this concept and taken a measure to eradicate this concept as some terrorist organizations ISIS and Al-Qaeda in the name of Islam are spreading violence among the rest of the world.

⑥ Political Disunity

Leaders of the Muslim Ummah have all failed to be on the same page for the betterment of the community rather all are getting and becoming a part of sectarianism. This Shia Vs Sunni debate has weakened the social fabric of the Islamic community and made one nation stand in front of the other rather than side by side.

b External Challenges faced by Muslim Ummah

① Colonization

Muslim countries have a history of subjugation under Western rule which had taken away the unity, integrity and moral values of Muslim world completely influencing them.
