For instance, the UNGA, United Nationp General Assembly is a very powerful organ of the UND, It can pass resolutions which can also have a legally binding effect in some cases. It has access to billions of dollars and helps in inproving the lives of million around the world In spite of this the Exter of the UND has certain afficles which limit and aut its power so that it does not breach the povereignty of ptates. Another peptinent enample of the necessary limits of power are the three branches of government - the executive, the legislature and the Judiciary which serve to decentralize power and prevent to accumulation in the hands of any one branch Thus, then are precedents in the practice of nations to show that a system of checks and balances ensures that power does not correcte into corruption. To conclude, this essay highlights numerous historical, regional, global and literary cases to analyze the

exercise of power by various individuals and nations. Some groups of men have violated the trust of power and its responsible use such as the curient Israeli regime and their ideological brothers in the BJP-RSS collusion in India.
