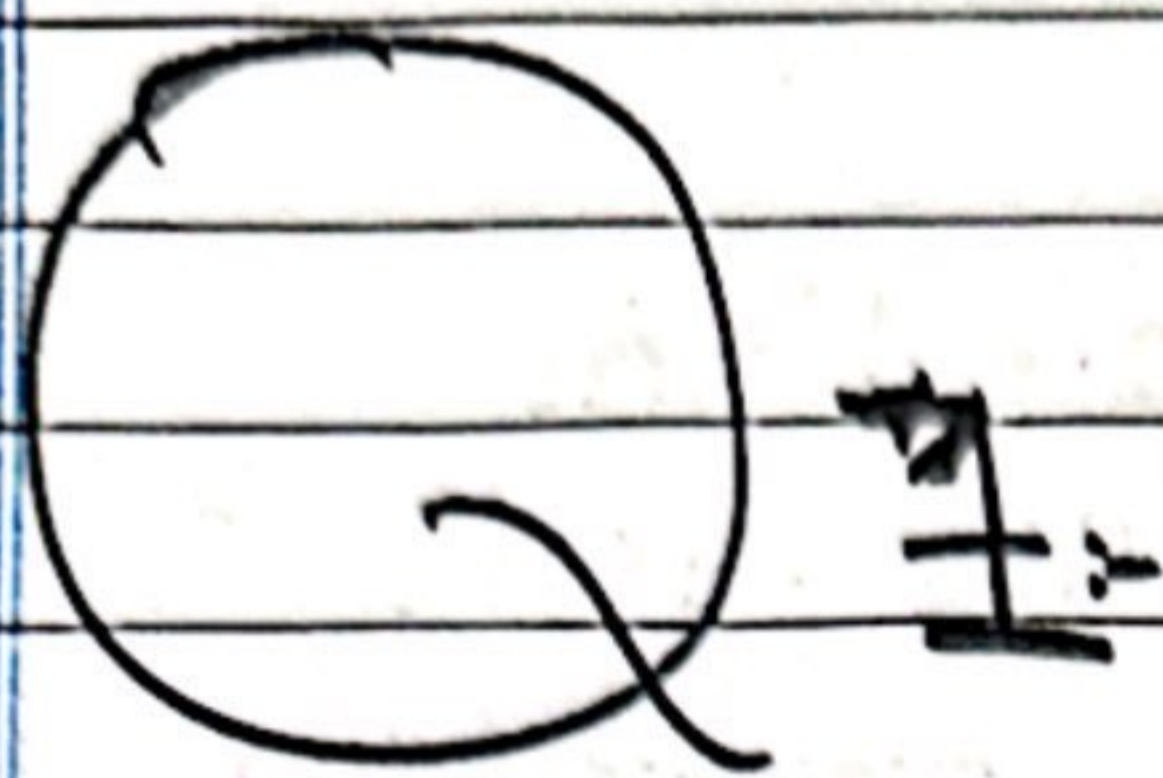


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Introduction:

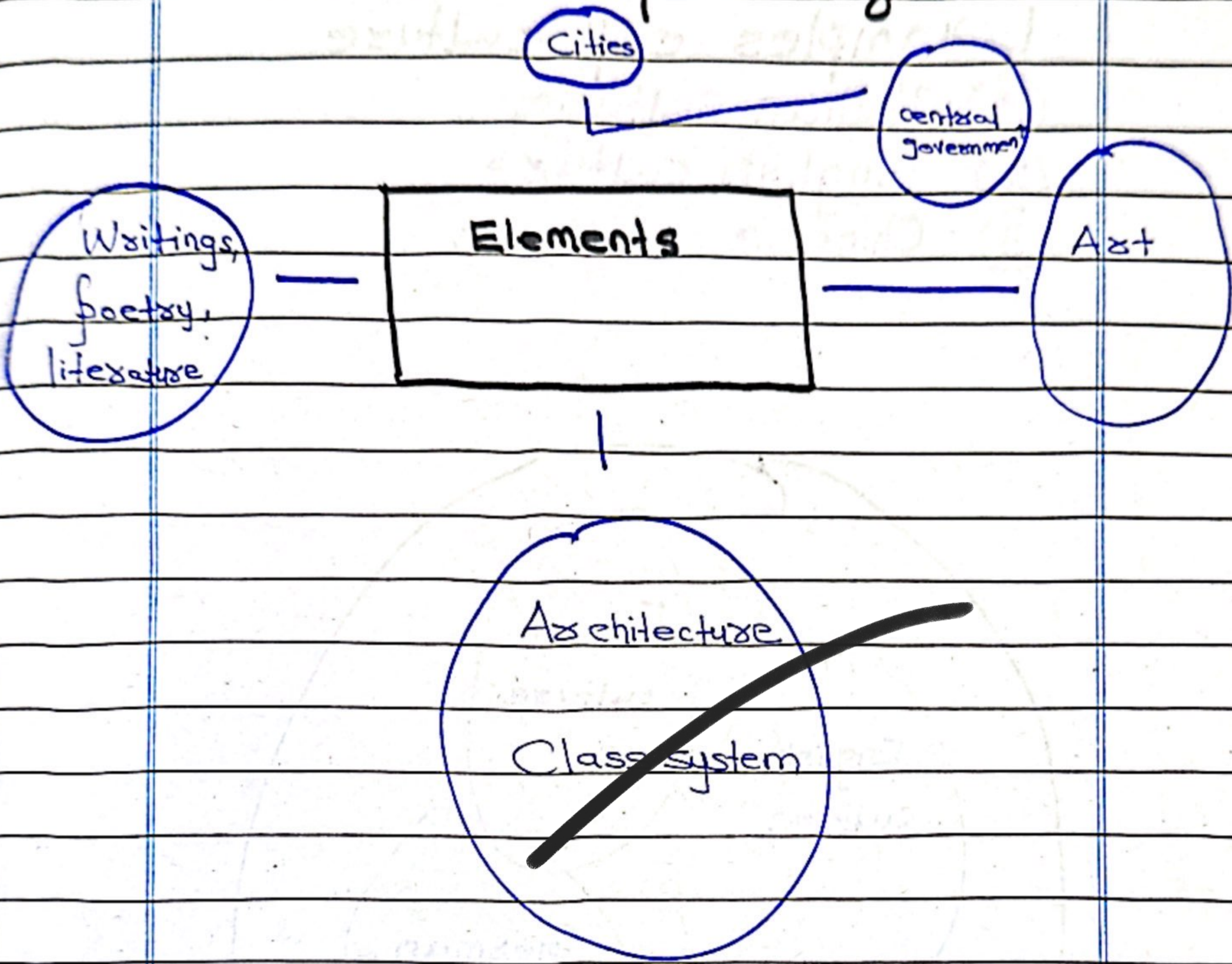

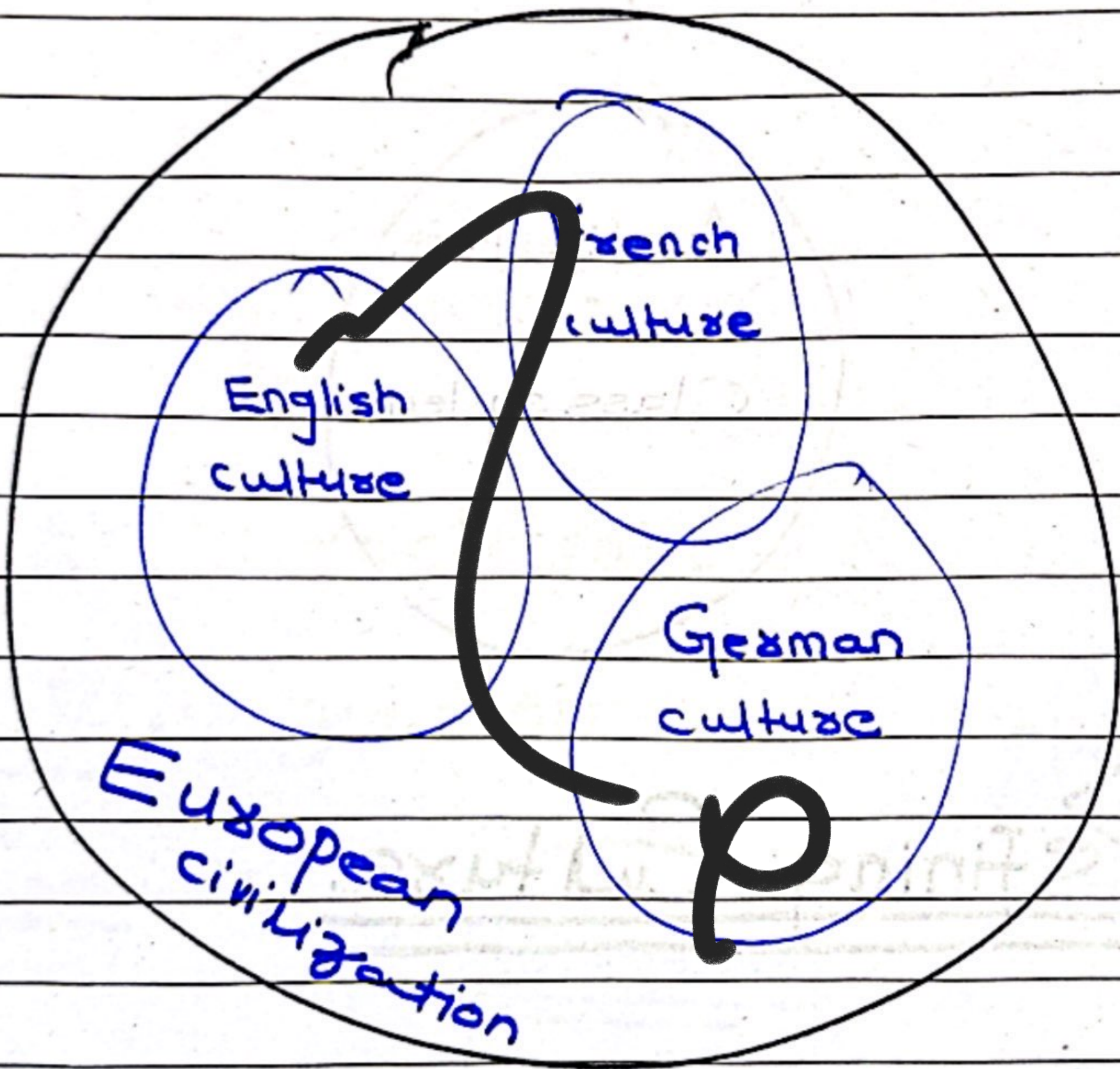


Defining Culture

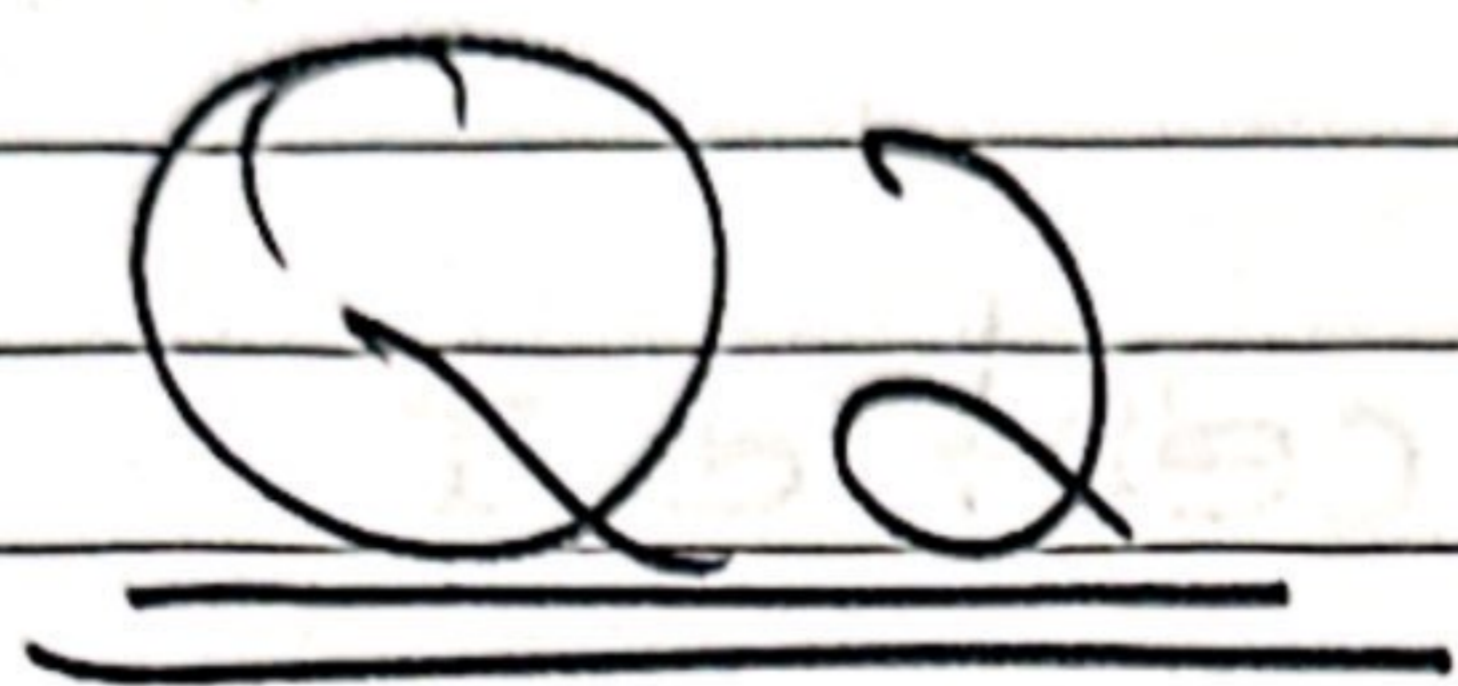

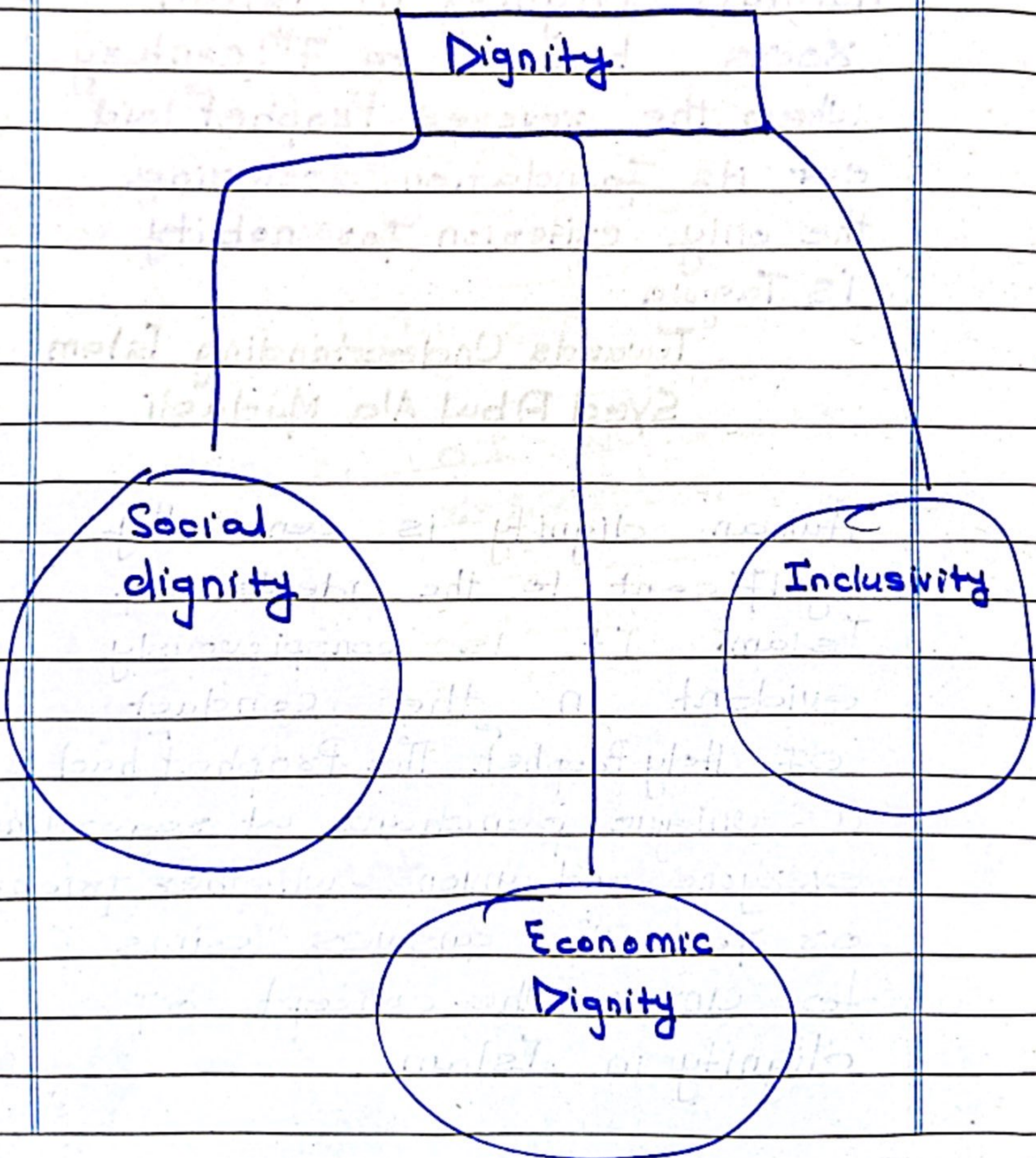
The Concept of human dignity in Islam roots back to 7th century when the revered Prophet laid out its foundation, declaring the only criterion for nobility is Taqwa
