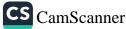



This absence of courts in Pakistan effated The ourciall performance of the juvenile justice in Pakistan, As This lead towards violation of Child rights, lack of legal framework, delaying justice for juvenile along with others. However, These should be countered to ensure effectiveness of juvenile justice system in Pakistan. JUVENILE JUSTICE SYSTEM IN PAKISTAN. The system of justice for the children or juveniles under the age of ninteen (19) is known as juvenile Joshie system.



In Patistan, There is absence of juvenile justice system proper implementation in Rukistan-As The joveniles are being trialed and presented to cost as other adult criminals. No court is present for the justice provision to juveniles. As in Only in Powelpindi and Islamabed more than 20,000 juveniles are present in jails along with criminals. This figure shows that no separate jail for The juveniles and no probation officer and courts for their decision. This has lead to serious Threat in uproming years when they will become more violent criminals and will cause hair in Palaistan. 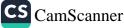


