Islam also devises a set-up principles to deal with childrens. Among many, one of the right of childrens and responsibility of parents mentioned in Quran.

"And don't kill you childrens for the fear of poverty. We provide for them, and for you. Killing them is a grave Sin." (Al-Uran)

Further, the third important relation is childrens treatment of their parents. So, Islam warn childrens to treat their parents with a good manners. As Allah says in Quran:
