## B. External issues

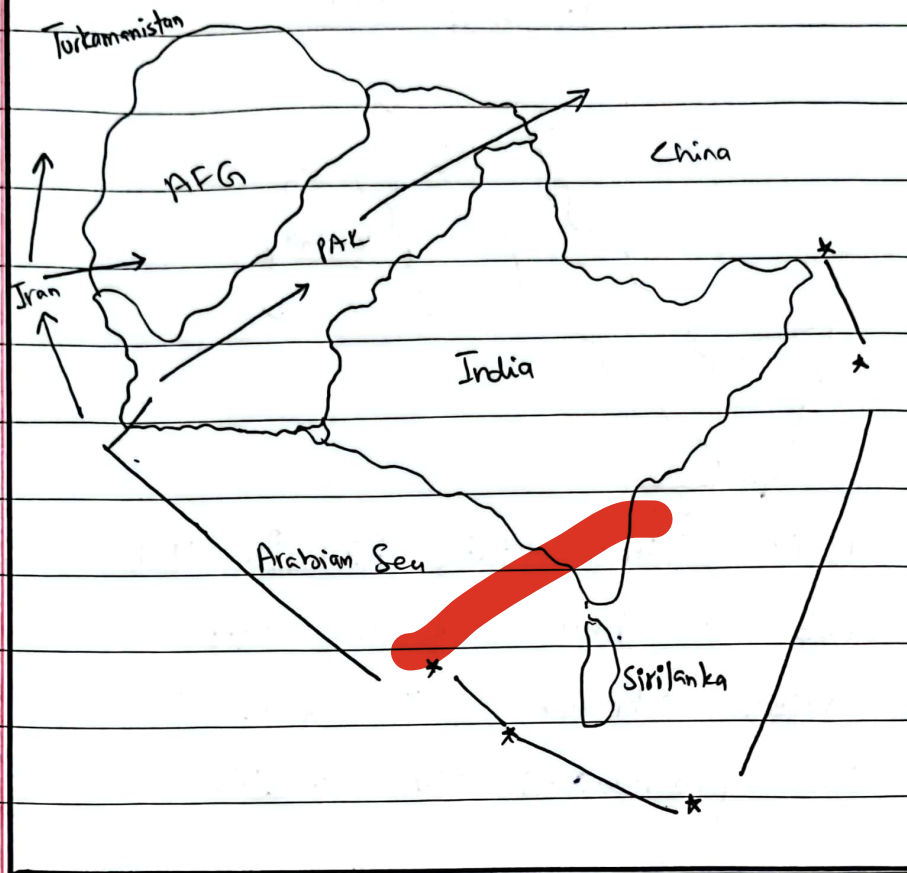
### 1B. US- Concerns about CPEC

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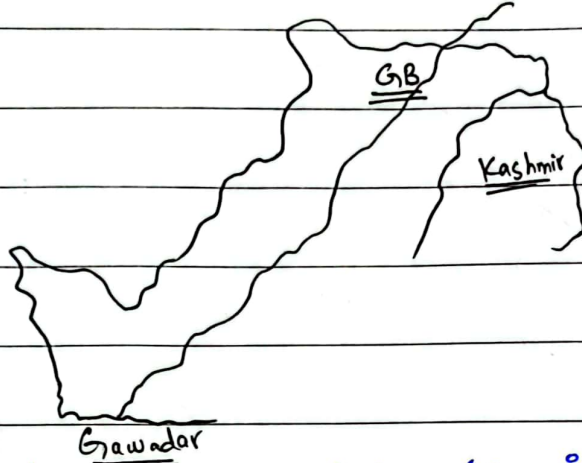
Countries. Just like in the picture :-

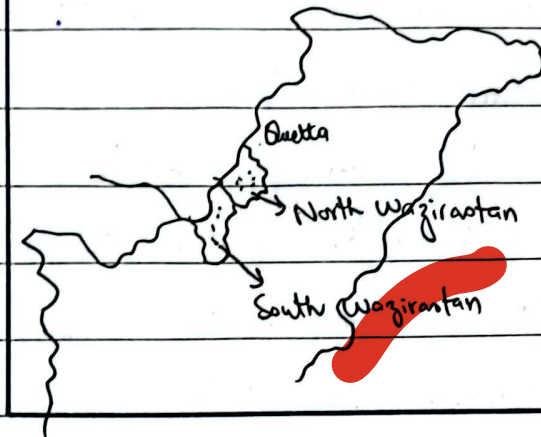
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"Nation who cannot control its economy and natural resources cannot control their future"

There is a great opportunity for BNP and JI to enhance their influence in Bangladesh. As these countries has played an important for the independence from Sheikh Hasina regime.

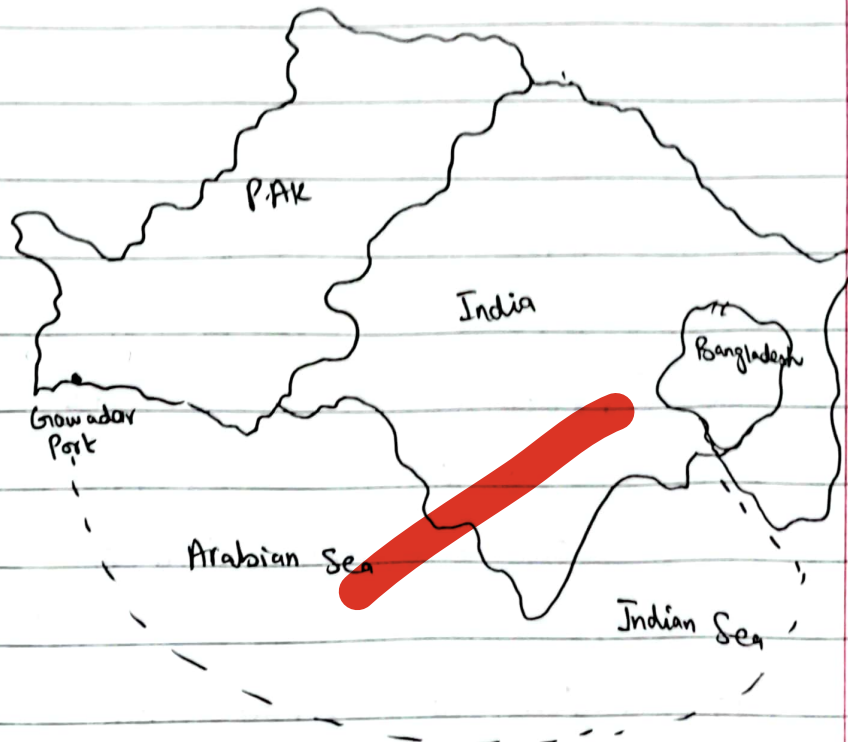
### D - Opportunity to enhance GDP and foreign policy to other countries like PAK

Economy of the country plays an important role to stabilize the situation of the country. Pakistan is facing economic challenges from (many) ~~about~~ its birth.

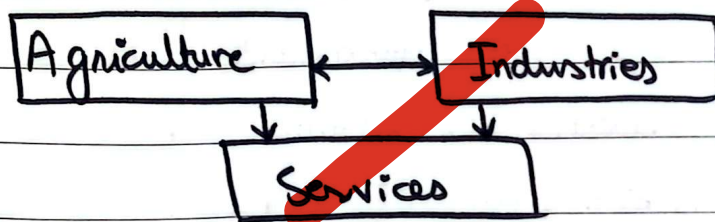

# 1- Pakistan's economy and structural reforms

A- Tax reforms through equal division between the Institutions of Pakistan

There are three dominant institutions in Pakistan:



These (Both) are working for the development of the country. But these institutions are basically not working equally and even they are not giving taxes equally.

For instance:

Agricultural Sector  
→ 0% tax

Industrial Sector  
→ 30% tax

Services sector  
→ 30% tax

Hence, there should be equal taxation so that they could be able to contribute more towards the economy.

### B- Reforms in the state owned enterprises

State owned enterprises for example:

PIA → 7.1 Billion Rs Loss

Railway → Also in Loss

PAK Steel Mill → Also in Loss

For this, the government should sell these enterprises, following the model of Thatcher, PM of England. Who sold her Railway to the locals and collected the revenue through taxes. It is for good for Pakistan as well, if she will follow the rule.

### C- Technological enhancement in research institutes

According to the reports a textile institute has made the fabric through Peel of Banana. And the

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Students 'also made the shirts through this fabric and exported to the others. It could be possible <sup>only</sup> with the help of government. ~~Or~~ The Pakistan government can also do work on this process. It would be <sup>more</sup> easy to sell the state-owned enterprises and to invest her money on these works.

### D- Shifting towards renewable energy from electricity

If Pakistan shifts towards the renewable energy resources as it is enriched with sunlight. It can shift its electricity towards solar panels.

According to the reports:

"Pakistan has become 1st most buying <sup>solar</sup> panels country from China"

But it could be beneficial only when the government will sell the solar panels at low prices. So that everyone could be able to buy them. Through shifting towards these panels, Pakistan will get rid of IPPs and grid stations as well.

## E- To lessen loans from IMF and World Bank

According to the World Bank report:

### To follow ↳ Chinese economic model

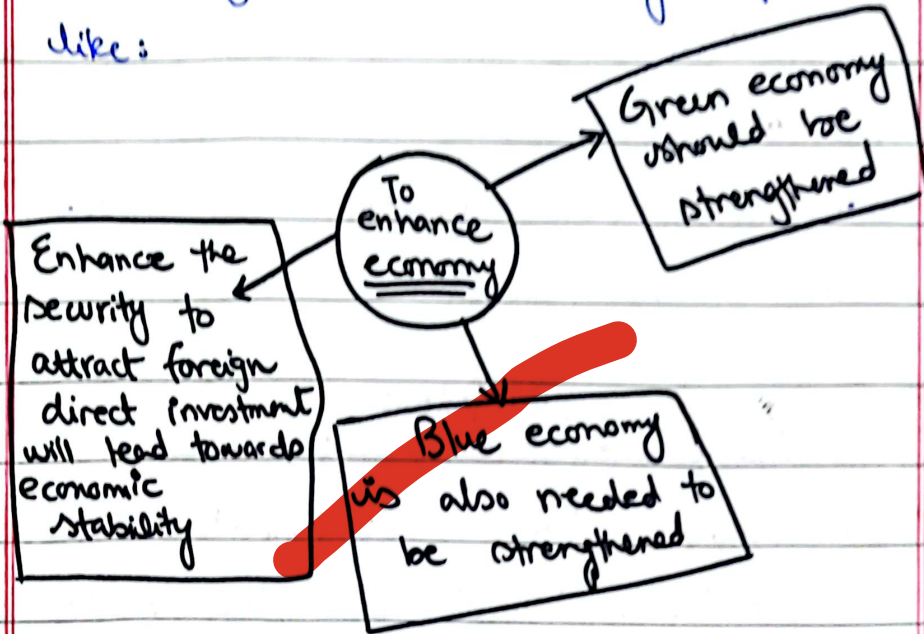
Although China's government is authoritarian based. But she made the policy to strengthen her local government to make the policy and collect revenue for the government.

As well as both countries need to have tight security <sup>on borders</sup> and internal security as well. Pakistan should also expect the Afghan nationals for creating peace.

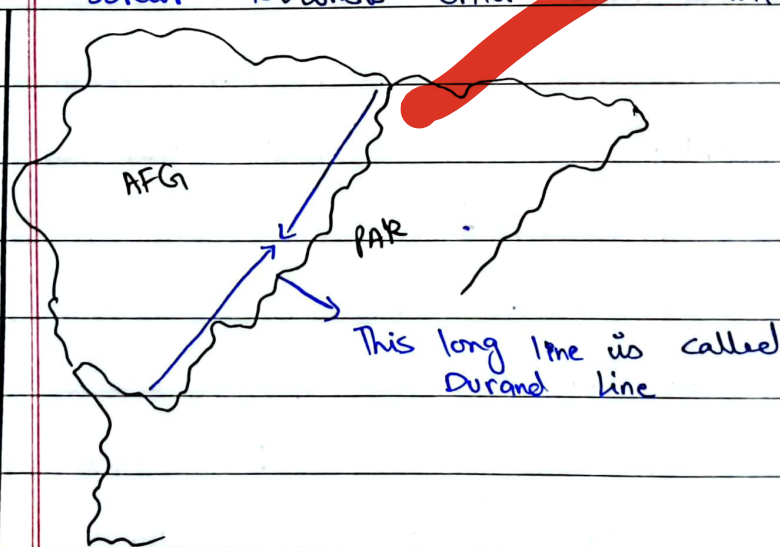
This discussion is based upon the challenges of Islamabad - Kabul relations and recommendation to do them better.

**"We have killed 90+ TTP terrorists in Kabul" (ISPR)**

## D- Afghanistan Contrastive claim on Pakistan

On the other hand, Afghanistan had claimed that, the attack did not kill any TTP member, but it killed 20+ children and women.

Hence, Afghanistan is not ready to accept to have TTP in their region. Rather their foreign minister told Pakistan in response of attack:

"If Pakistan has Babar missile, we have so many Babars in our country"

It indicates a tension between both countries.

## 4- Recommendations to get through this issue

(A) Negotiations between  
both countries

This problem can only be get through if both countries could

talk on this problem. But Afghanistan is not accepting it to talk with Pakistan.

### (B) Security on both countries borders

Another recommendation is that both countries need to strengthen the security on borders. As it is a long border. There should be (need) necessary to create more check posts and there should be separate night and morning shifts. So that security could be tightened without any sleep. As it is said that:

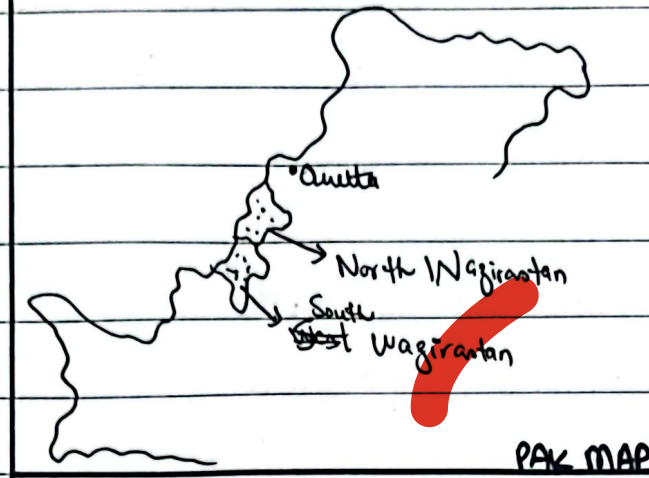
"PAK Army is one of the greatest Army of the world. (ISPR)"
