Follow the Given Instructions to get Good Marks in Precis

- \* Understand the original text thoroughly before attempting to write a precis.
- \* Determine the central theme or message of the text.
- \* Avoid copying sentences directly from the original text. Express the ideas in your own words.
- \* A precis should be much shorter than the original text (in Single Passage). Aim for about one-third the length.
- \* Use clear and simple language, avoiding jargon or complex sentence structures.
- \* Use short, straightforward sentences to convey information effectively.
- \* Prefer active voice over passive voice to make your writing more concise and engaging.
- \* Choose words that accurately and succinctly express the ideas.
- \* Avoid unnecessary words or phrases that do not add to the meaning.
- \* Present the information without adding your own opinions or interpretations.
- \* Ensure your precis is well-written and error-free.
- \* Don't write in 1st and 2nd person Pronouns in Precis

i) The environment impact of renewable energy production is same like half of the traditional fossil fuels. The solar panels and the wind turbines are the renewable energy sources but their production involve the use of green house gases. For example, solar panel needs rare earth elements like cadmium and tellurium whose extraction needs mining practices which results in environment pollution.

Write in single passage

The use of the traditional fossil fuels like coal, gas and petroleum directly causes the environment pollution by generating green house gases. So both renewable energy production and traditional fossil fuels have impact on the environment.

ii) The electric vehicles are also not environment friendly as their production results in the pollution. Materials used for the production of electric vehicles require mining process.

Lithium, Cobalt and nickel used in the production of ER. Mining of these elements results in loss of habitat, soil contamination and water shortages in that particular area. Hence, the ER are not environment friendly.
