A-1= The renewable energy production also leaves the environmental impacts like the traditional fossil fuels. The production process of renewable energy sources like solar panels and wind turbines emits vast quantity of greenhouse gases in the air. Moreover, their installation also results in deforestation which impacts the wildlife and in turn environment.

A-2= Electric vehicles cannot be regarded as a complete solution to the pollution. The batteries used in such vehicles require materials like nickel, cobalt. These minerals are extracted through mining, which generates pollution. Moreover, these vehicles require electricity for charging. Along with it, the disposal of their batteries also leads to pollution.

A-3= The solar panels and wind turbines have a life time of 20 to 30 years. At the end of their life, it is not easy to recycle them. It results in

accumulation of their leftovers. Without proper infrastructure, they cannot be discarded properly and leads to pollution.

- * Avoid unnecessary words or phrases that do not add to the meaning.
- * Present the information without adding your own opinions or interpretations.
- * Ensure your precis is well-written and error-free.
