(v) Unemployment in the Pakistan.


Unemployment in the Pakistan is the basic problem that has been continuously increasing.

Pakistan's foreign policy towards the Middle East has always been in the priority.


Relations with Arab countries, KSA, Iran, Kuwait and Oman.
