It would be a severe mis-conception to think that renewable energy production is hundred percent cleaner and efficient than traditional alternatives such as oil, natural gas and coal. For instance, it is true that energy produced by solar panels or windmills is much cleaner but the problem lies in the manufacturing of solar panels or wind turbines, which not only drains human and financial resources but also exploits labour during the mining process of rare earth elements.

Electric vehicles as a product are super environment friendly. But, the core component of any EV is lithium-ion batteries which is manufactured by rare

earth elements such as lithium, Nickel and cobalt. Obviously, the machinery used to extract these minerals runs on the consumption of fossil fuels, which contributes significantly to air pollution making EV's benefit less significant. Unless this flaw is addressed, any effort for preservation of environment will prove futile.

After the life span of a renewable energy system ends, its disposal becomes the most challenging part. For instance, a battery of EV consists of many heavy metals which if disposed openly can cause damage to animals, humans and fish. Similarly, solar panels and wind turbines, having a life span of 20-30 years, pose a significant risk if they are not managed or disposed properly. For example, solar panels and wind turbines consist of different components which make their segregation at solid-waste-recycling facility very difficult.

The article suggests that renewable energy systems are not entirely pollution free even during its operational phase. For example, while solar panels and wind turbine produce environment friendly energy, it still relies on batteries for the storage of energy, and the process of production of battery is already notorious, as it involves inhumane mining practices and ^{poor} conditions of working at mines which does not only cause environmental degradation but also contribute to human rights abuses.
