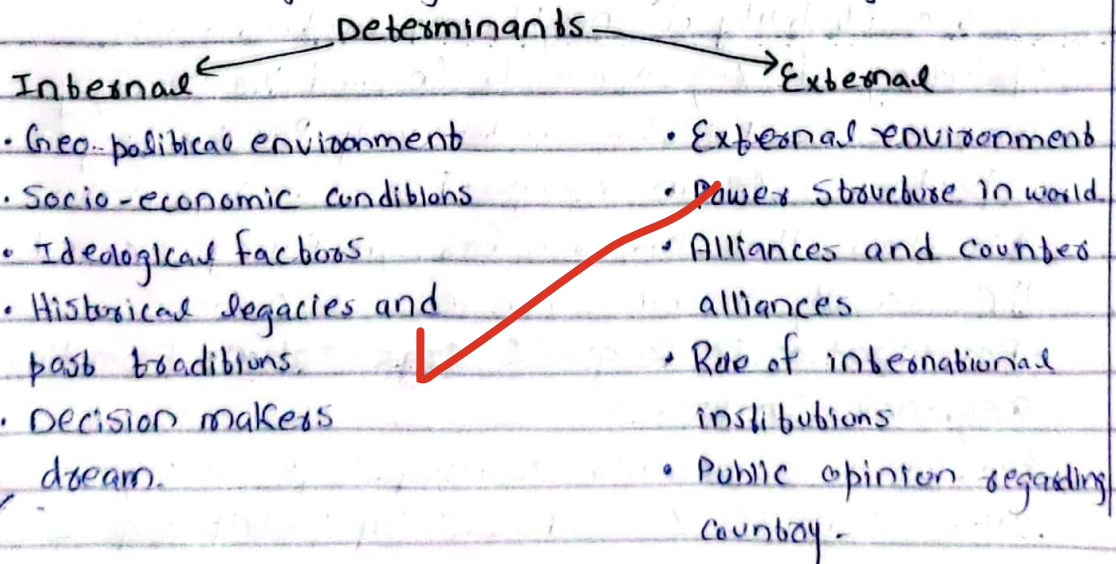

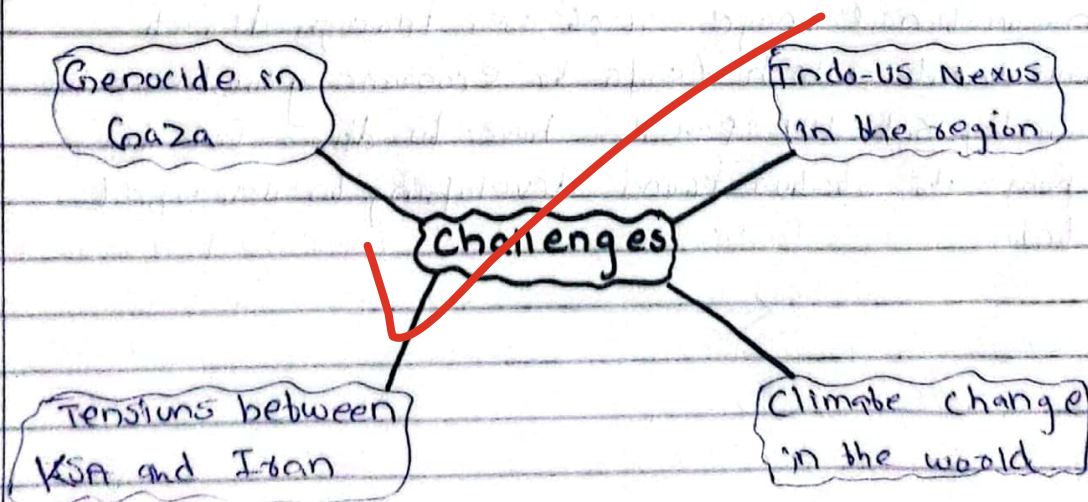
• Promoting Peace and Stability lessened the security concerns:
