Pakistan has successfully conducted SCO in Islamabad. Critically evaluate the major takeaways for Pakistan. What measures would you recommend to follow?

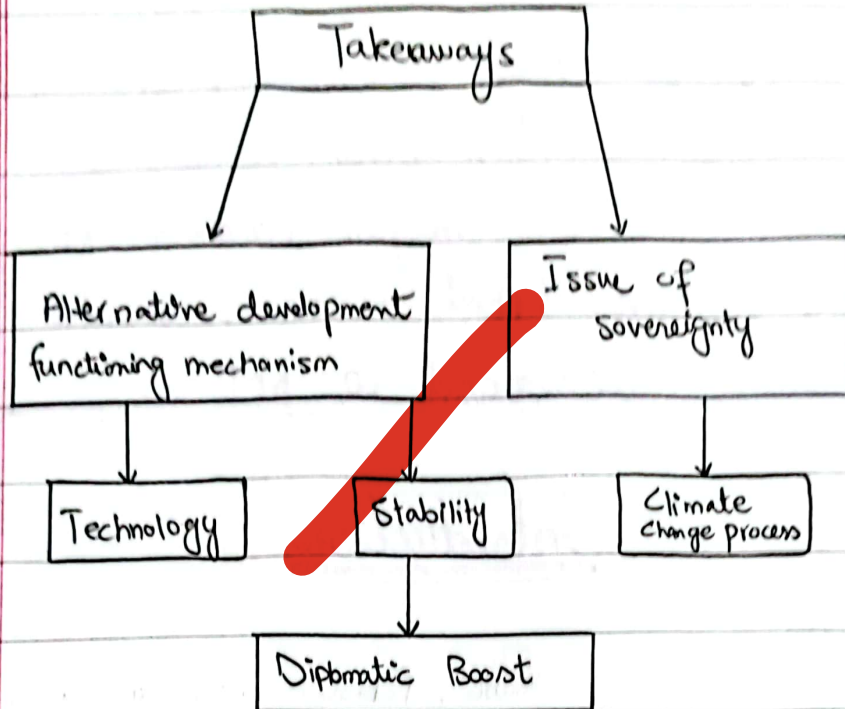

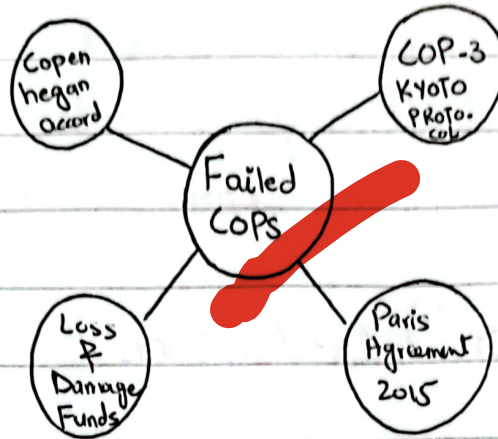
COP29 summit ended in Baku. Critically evaluate its failures and commitments.

they will also lead towards lame excuses.

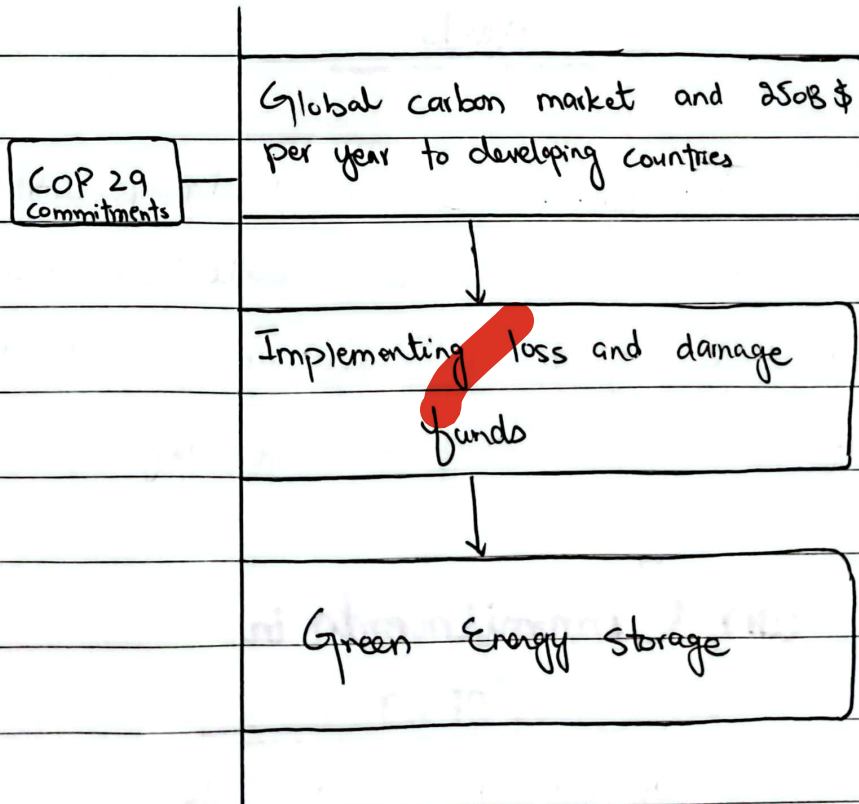
For instance:

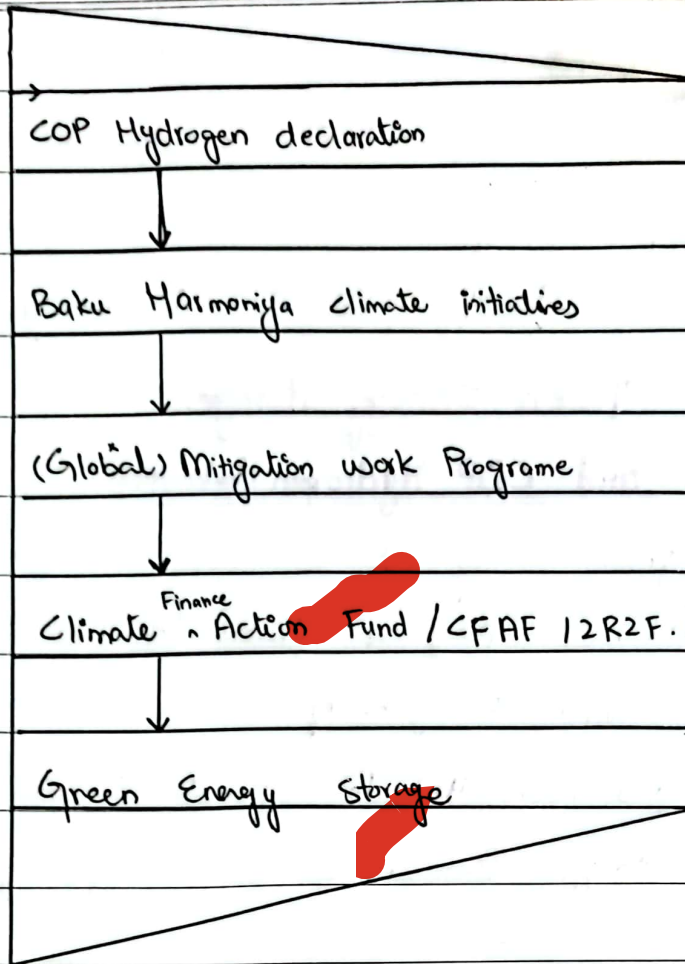
COP members agreed to provide funds by January 2025. And Donald Trump will never grant funds as he said that:

At COP29, it was aimed that to provide loss and damage funds abruptly at the end of January 2025. But it is impossible, as Donald Trump will not let them grant.

Green Energy storage and COP Hydrogen declaration

It's Green energy storage and COP hydrogen declaration can play a fundamental role in clean environment globally.

It was committed to generate 1500 Gw of energy storage from renewable energy by 2030.

While some countries committed to use hydrogen energy (Blue energy) production from the technology for zero-emission.

"Recently India launched Green source technology for low carbon production"

Baku Harmoniya climate

The countries committed to grant aid to those farmers of the world who have been suffering from food security due to climate change.

But it seems, like other projects this initiative will also be not accomplished.

Mitigation work Programme

Like Copenhagen accord, mitigation work programme is also a funding programme of 300 B\$ aid. But it is too less for above hundred of countries for clean development projects.

Following the aid of 100 B\$, all countries objected and demanded for 1.3 Trillion dollars.

But only 300 B\$ aid was accepted. That is definitely, will not be provided.

Climate Action Fund

(2R2F)

Azerbaijan introduced climate action fund CFAF / 2R2F. That is seeking annual contribution of 1 B\$.

2R → Rapid Fund + Rapid Response
↳ in case of any emergency

GF → Immediate Fund in case of any disaster

Funds will also be used in renewable energy projects and support climate projects in developing countries.

But still it is not accomplished like other projects.
