As this is the single motivation case of Nisha Rao for the whole transgender community, but the actual problems of their recognition can not be ignored that transgender people face multiple problems in Edifying Systems, their enrollment is the first issue and then the institutions are not normalised to deal with any other gender where the acceptance of their existence is again under question mark. role to motivate them and

 they developed in cisgender  
 to at least give a space  
 to groom or develop themselves
