2- Major aspects of Islam:

(1) Tauheed: Tauheed refers

refers to the oneness of Allah. He has no relatives nor has given birth to anyone. Tauheed is the bedrock of Islam. Every principle of Islam revolves around the principle of Tauheed.

② Equality of all:

Islam does not discriminate between human beings. It enjoins rights and duties upon each and every human equally. ~~eg~~ the prophet Muhammad PBUH said, in his last sermon that no one has superiority over any one, except on the basis of piety.

③ Brotherhood:

Islam unites the Muslims under the banner of brotherhood. It induces a sense of brotherhood through faith. ~~eg~~ The prophet Muhammad PBUH likened Muslims as a body when one part hurts the whole body becomes uncomfortable.

(4) Accountability:

Accountability is a main covenant of Islam. It means every individual will be held responsible for their actions. ~~before~~ One of the characteristics of Allah SWT is "munisif", meaning the one who does justice. Allah will judge everyone bit by bit for their actions.

(5) Purpose of humanity


Islam has given purpose to humanity which is the most beautiful aspect of it. It has clearly laid down the purpose of humans as; doing good, restraining from bad and remembering Allah all the time. In reward, those who have belief in Allah and follow his commands will be given jannah. Moreover, purposeful life secures a person from falling

prey to Nihilism, which is state of disbelief in reality. This state of mind leads to catastrophe, grief ~~and~~, depression and mental illnesses.

(6) The concept of reward and punishment:

- ⑥ It lay down the fram work for an individuals interaction with another individual and Allah swt.



2- Major beliefs in Islam
