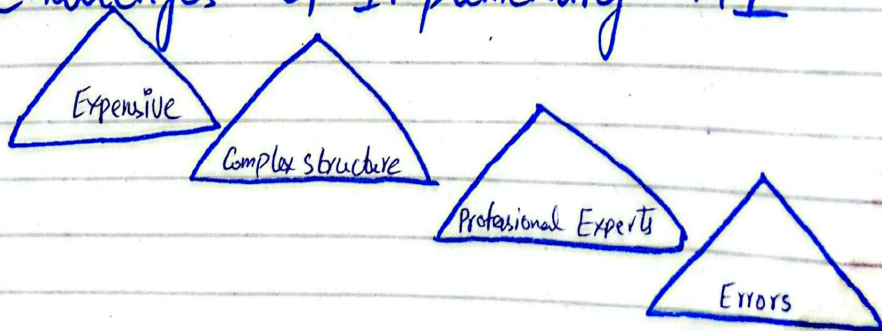

Industrial smoke

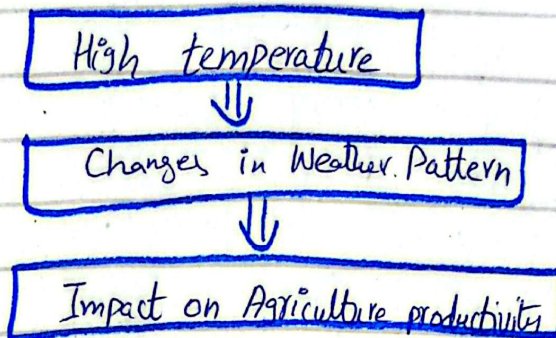
Cutting of greenery

Effects of Global Warming:

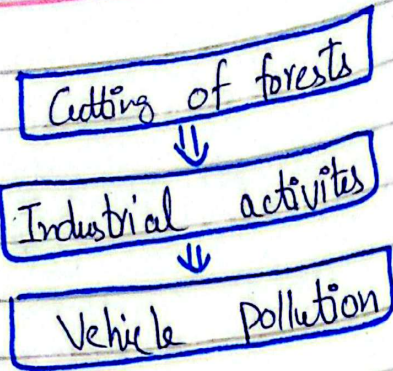
The effects of global warming are given below:

Human activities in contributing global warming:

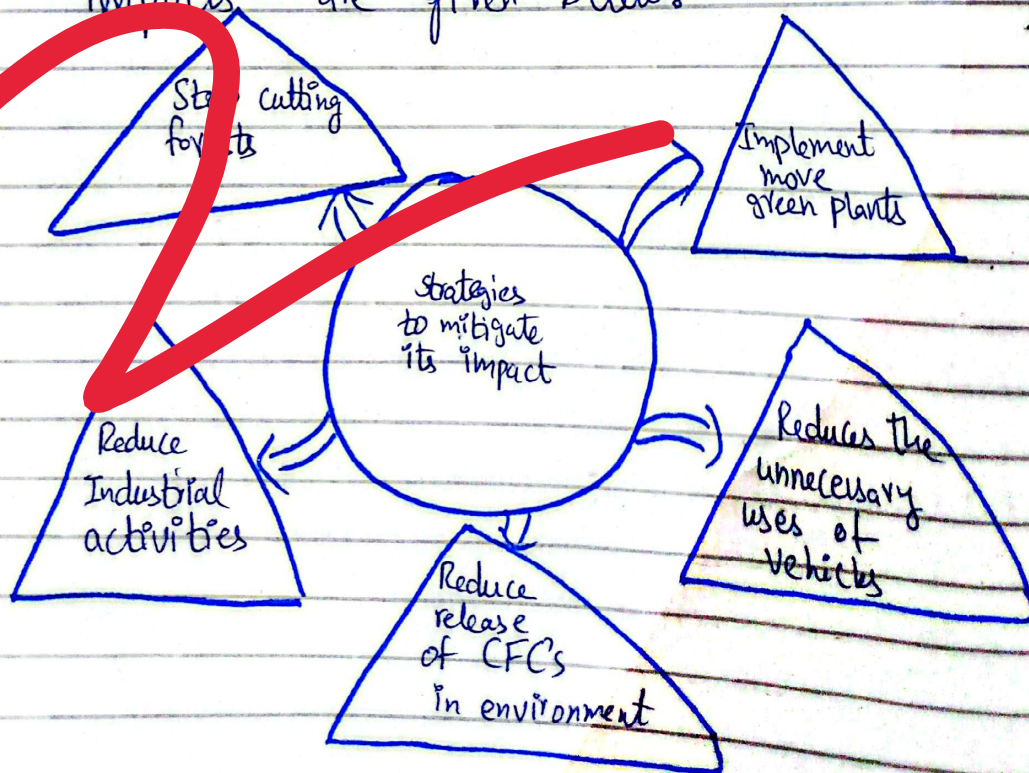
Following human activities contribute in global warming:
