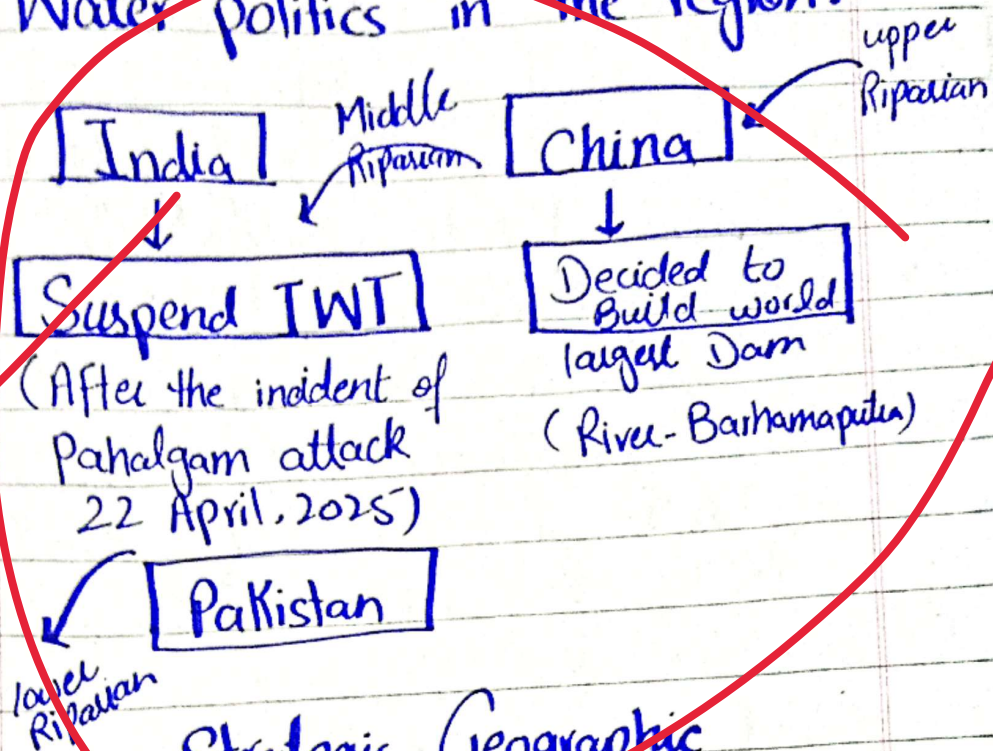

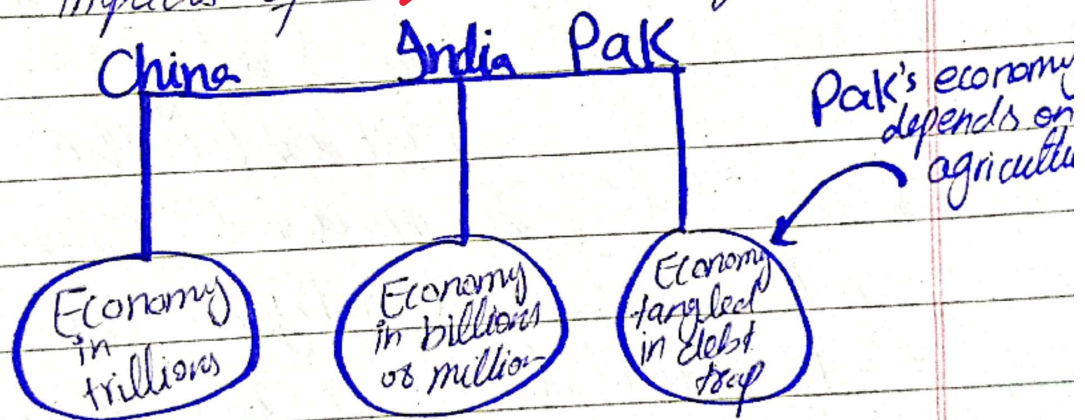
Impacts of climate change:

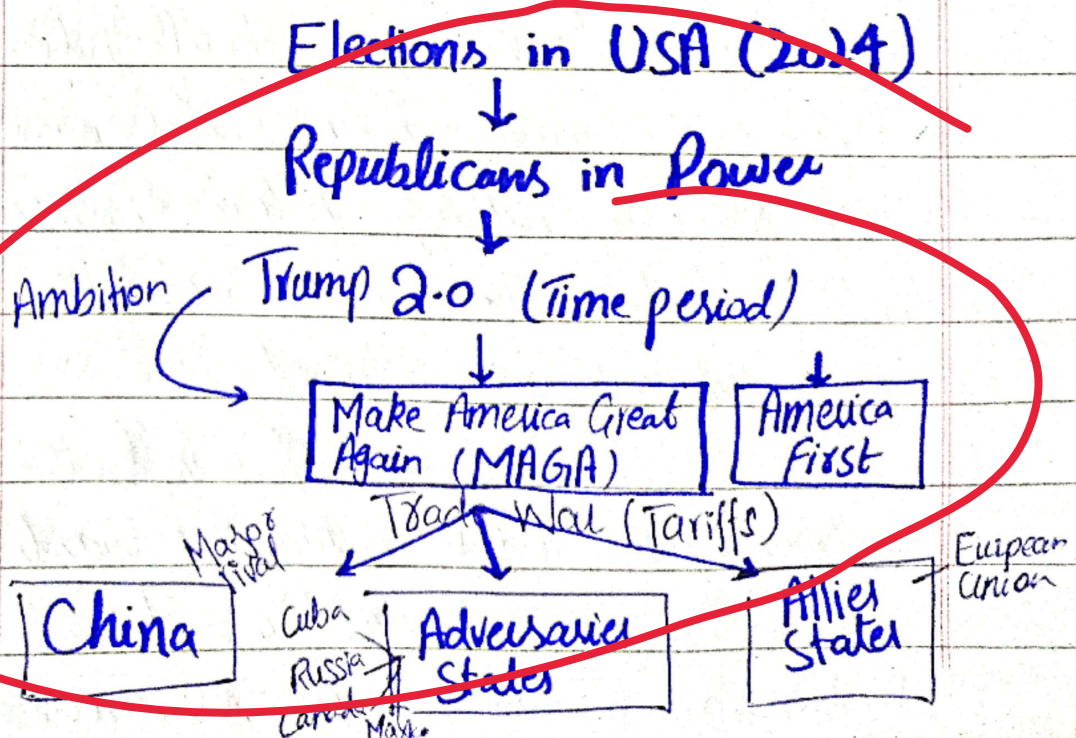

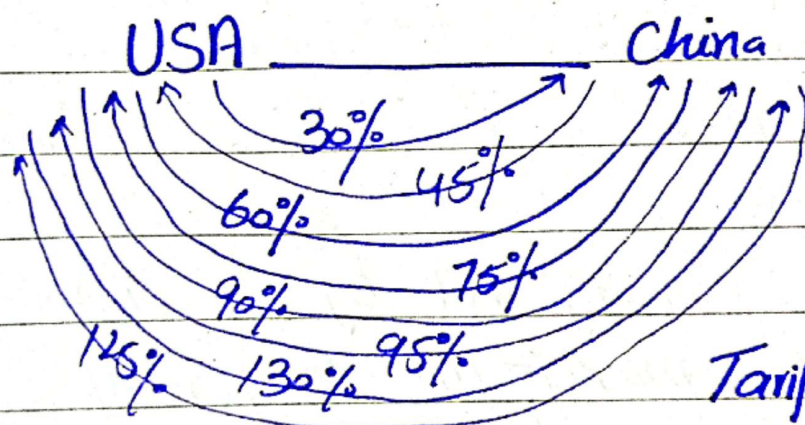

for China:**



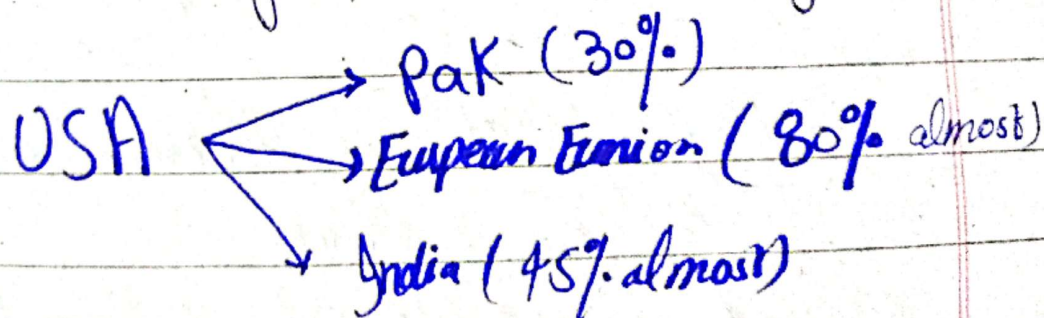

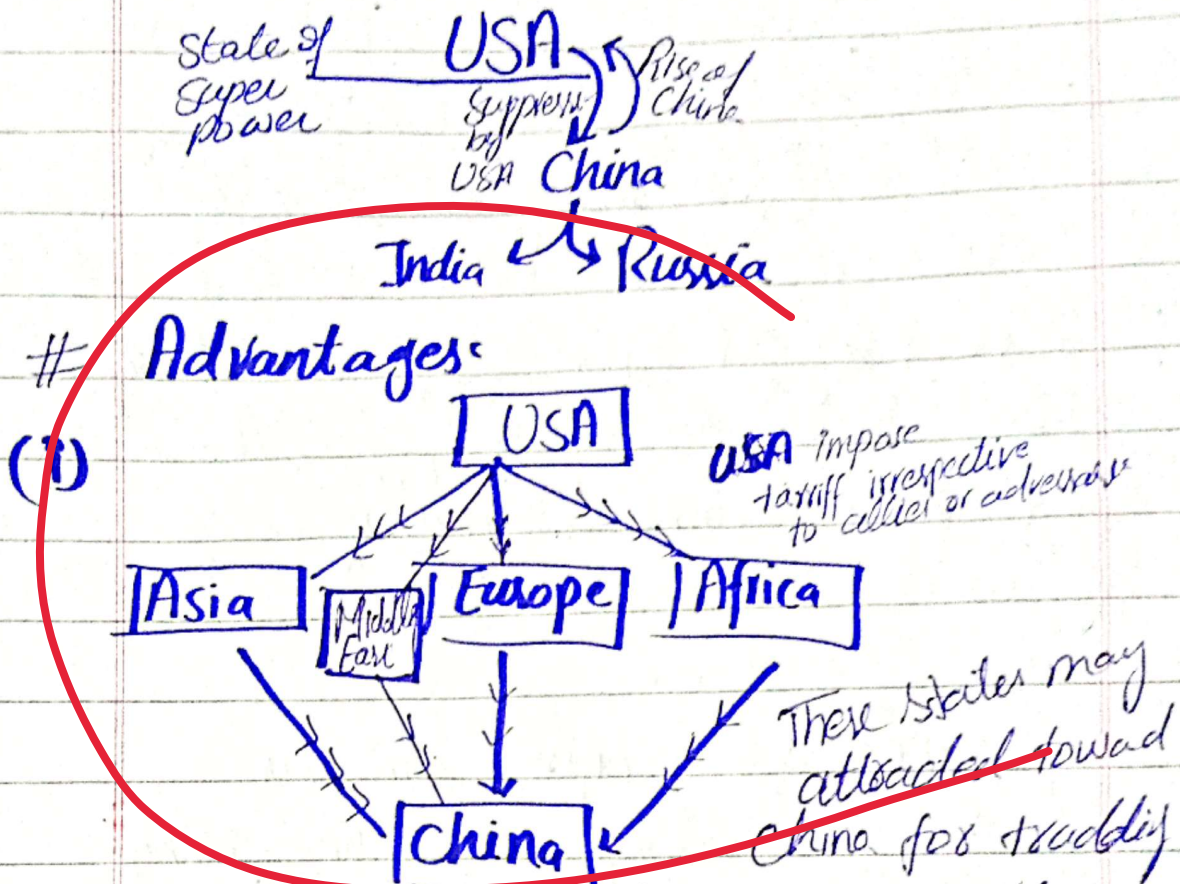
Challenges for China:

(vii) USA wants to remain at the highest state in this Thucydide trap.

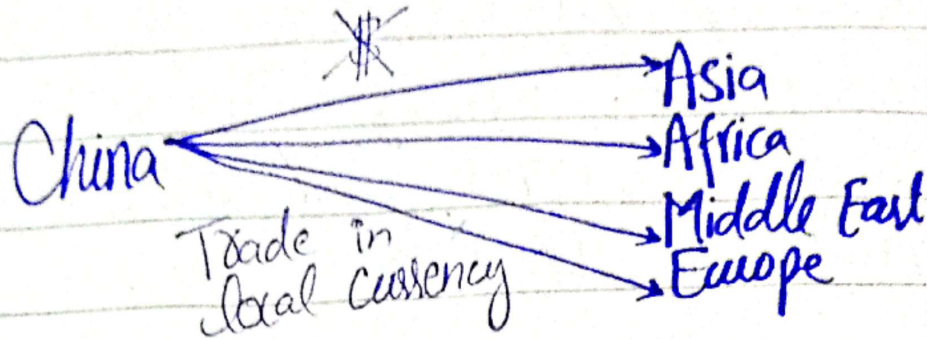

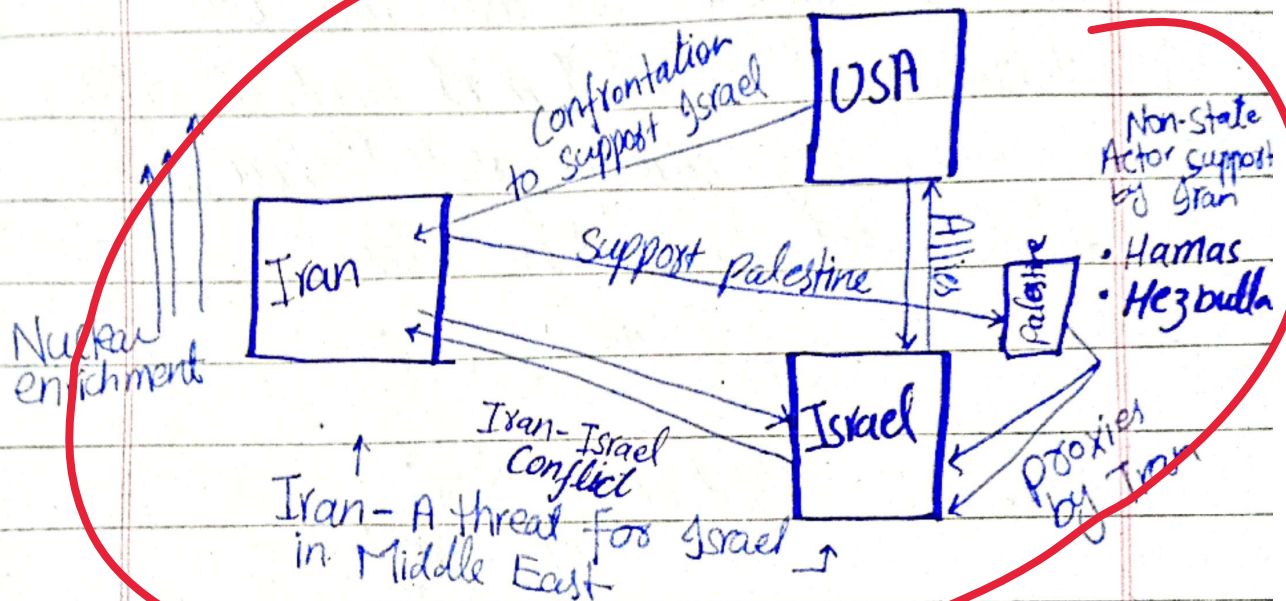

Historical Background.

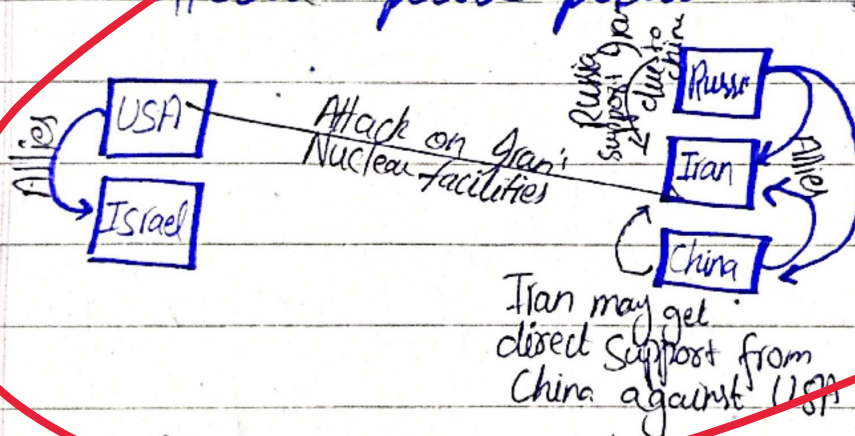
