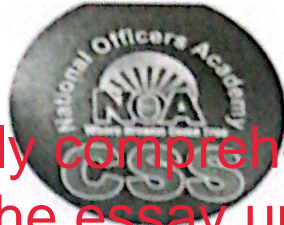


General instructions to be followed to pass essay
