Social factors such as drug culture, peer pressure and desire to fit in also lures young people towards drug abuse - people start doing drugs because they want to conform to trends and norms - Environment factors such as presence of drug abusers in family and community, drug-friendly environment and availability of drugs can also lead to drug abuse. Often drug abuse starts with experimental use of recreational drugs in social settings such as friend's group during adolescence and young adulthood. As time passes this recreational use becomes frequent and one needs larger doses of drugs to get high and soon enough they addicts need drugs just to feel normal. All these factors are present in Pakistani community that lead to drug addiction among Pakistani youth.
