by the government. Unfortunately, the judiciary of Pakistan is not independent having checks and balances by the executive and legislature. The main reasons for the lack of independence of Pakistan's judiciary are abolishment of suo-moto power, greater influence of parliament over judiciary and the establishment of federal constitutional court. The appointment of judges, unlimited prestigious for chief of Defence (COD) and president is the main cause that affects the independence of Pakistan's judiciary. Unless the judiciary of Pakistan is independent, the country will not be successful or prosperous.

Firstly, the greater influence of executive and legislature over the judiciary is a big setback for the Pakistan's judiciary independence. The work of legislature and executive is to make laws and implement them effectively. Judiciary can take action

against any law proved by the parliament and secure the fundamental rights of the citizens. By the changes in constitutions of Pakistan with the help of **27th amendment** passed on **13 Nov, 2025** by the parliament and signed by President. In this amendment, according to **Article 200 and 175**, the executive and legislature have greater influence over judiciary in judicial appointments. Now, the parliament has checks and balances on the actions of Supreme courts. For this purpose, the judiciary works for the interests of parliament. For example, in the case of Tamizuddin, the supreme court Lahore reject this case and forward it to the Supreme Court, Islamabad. The greater influence of Parliament over the judiciary affects the independence of Pakistan's judiciary.

Secondly, the judiciary is controlled by the government and works according to their benefits. The appointment of

judges of Supreme Court is done by the constitutional bench present in Supreme Court. Constitutional bench is established under the **26th amendment** and consists of the members of Parliament. In this way, the appointment of Chief Justice of Supreme Court is according to their own interests. The Chief Justice take every action for the well being of government official, not the country. For example, the resignation of two senior judges of Supreme Court including **Mansoor Ali Shah and Justice Athar** against the **27th amendment**. They claimed that the 27th amendment is for the lifetime rule of Chief of Defence and President, which suffered the people of a country. The judiciary is bounded to the interests of parliament and military senior official, not for the welfare of country. The judiciary of Pakistan is not remained
