To begin with, management's approach to growth of individual creates better efficiency than perfecting his skills. According to Behavioral Theory of Management, investing on individual increases productivity of an organization. This is because he/she has more motivation to perform his/her task.

Therefore, companies and organizations invest heavily in Human resource. People are constantly trained to give them a new sense of purpose. Companies like Ronin fund their employees to attain Master degree from well reputed universities, as it ultimately benefits their business operation. On the

contrary, perfection in management causes demotivation and a loss of productivity.

During Industrial Revolution, Classical Theory of Management became popular. It focused on specialization of worker, polishing their responsibilities to perfection.

However, it agitated them, resulting in formation of labour unions to protect labour rights. Hence, it is critical to focus on growth of employee rather than higher specialization to enhance productivity.

Moreover, it raises total revenue of the corporate entities. Product life cycle, a marketing term, is an integral part of company's survival, focusing on growth over perfection. Product life cycle is the stages the product goes through before it becomes saturated in the market. These stages

depend on consumer's needs and preferences. Once the preferences change, the product becomes less relevant in the market. Therefore, it will be risky to continue perfecting the existing product.

Rather, the companies establish more products into the market to address the demands. Due to intense market competition, it must continuously innovate and bring new product lines. A classic example is of Nokia and Apple.

Nokia perfected the existing product while Apple went through constant innovation. Consequently, Nokia lost its phone market while Apple became the top smart phone brand valued in trillions.

Hence, continuous growth in product management is essential for better revenue and strong footing in the market.

Capitalism has resulted in exponential <sup>economic</sup> growth despite better social

aspects of marxism. According to  
 Karl Marx, capitalist societies exploit  
 poor for their own benefits. However,  
 Capitalism has resulted in more social  
 progress than Marxism. This is due to

 Businesses compete to provide better

Feminist framework, it encouraged women to grow in accordance to their unique culture, language and challenges. Hence, women were encouraged to grow uniquely to their environments rather than perfecting their equality rights.

The consistent need to update education system is more relevant to the current times. ~~The~~ The world is exponentially progressing due to globalization, capitalism and technological advancement. Hence, the established system of education is becoming less relevant. There is an urgent need to shift ~~into~~ policy framework for education. One that constantly adjusts with changing times. Flexible governance is crucial to enhance efficiency in the affairs of

the state. In many countries like Pakistan, Max Weber's Bureaucratic model is followed in the system of governance. It is a rigid approach that standardises authority, qualifications, promotions and hierarchy. Resultantly, redtaping and inefficiency slows down governance. On the other hand, corporate giants adopted a flexible system in their organizations. Their organizational structure depends on the functions of the organization. For example, marketing department in corporate structure works better under democratic leadership style. Whereas, the finance department may adopt autocratic leadership style.
