Begins with the first cause of workplace harassment, poverty which enforced the people to work for their livelihood. Poverty is the main reason behind every wrongful act. Pakistan has become the fifth-most

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populated country with **251 million** population according to **World Bank**. The rising population demand resources for their survival. The increased population has raised the concerns of people for establishing industries and factories for fulfilling the needs of people. There are many private forums, hotels, factories, industries and offices where women work for their livelihood. According to World Bank, there are **44.7%** of the population which live under the poverty line. For the better growth of their families, females come out of their houses for work. They are enforced to work at low wages in private forums for their survival of life. These women keep working and face workplace harassment continuously. Poverty is the main reason which triggered the women to work for their families and faces workplace harassment. This is also increased due to the lack of education in women.

Secondly, women with high **illiteracy** rate

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are the main cause of workplace harassment. The increasing unemployment forced the parents to drop out their children from schools and push towards child labor. There is about **27%** of child labour in Pakistan. According to the survey of Pakistan, there is about **60% of urban women** and **80% of rural women** which are facing workplace harassment. The illiterate women are forced to be work at lower ranks with low salaries and faced workplace harassment. There are many children which work at autoshops, hotels, and with other illegal groups face child abuse, harassment and severe punishments. There is a lack of awareness related to education which forced the children and women to work for their survival and face workplace harassment. There is a policy of "**More hands, more Money**" main factor of workplace harassment.
