(a)

Persons A and B share pizza in the Ratio =

$$5:3$$

Slices in pizza = 8

Slices each person receive = ?

Total ratio of both persons = $5+3 = 8$

To find slices of each, use formula

$$\text{share}_A = \frac{\text{Ratio of A}}{\text{Total Ratio}} \times \text{Total slices.}$$

$$\text{share}_A = \frac{5}{8} \times 8 = 5$$

$$\text{share}_B = \frac{3}{8} \times 8 = 3.$$

So,

Person A receives 5 slices and

Person B receives 3 slices.

Black Holes

Defination:

A Black hole is an extremely dense point with infinite mass through which nothing can escape including light.

How Black Hole is formed

Black hole forms through following stages in a dense stars

- (i) Balance of force/pressure and gravity of star; Black hole is formed from dense stars after fusion reaction for millions of years. Initially, gravity of star is balanced by fusion reaction. Fusion of hydrogen and helium produce explosive forces, which are balanced by gravity of the star.

- (ii) The Death of star: Reduction of

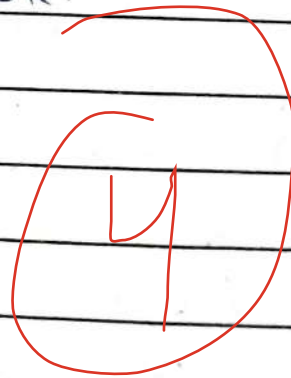
gravity: After burning for millions of years, fuel of star ends. Then gravity reduces and ^{*}(explosive forces)^{*} dominates gravity of star

(iii) Domination of gravity

As gravity dominates so, mass of star also ~~de~~ increases because higher gravity of particles of star attract more mass from space. In this way mass of star and eventually gravity of star becomes extremely high and strong.

(iv) Black hole formed from dead

star : Eventually, gravity rises so ^{high} that ~~to~~ even light can't escape, it is called black hole.

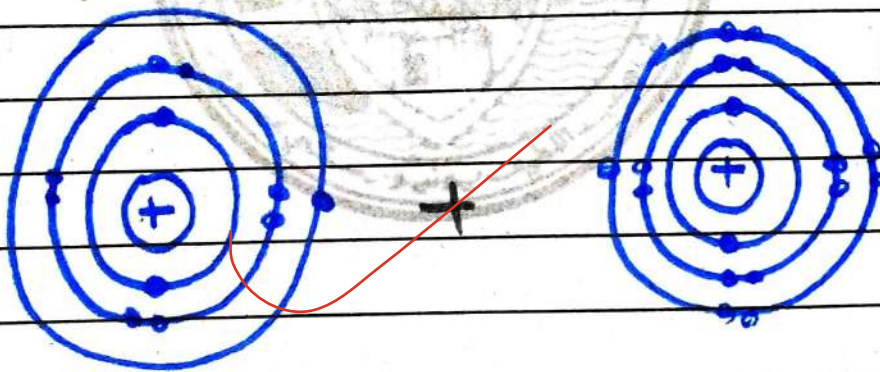


(b) Octet Rule

Atoms acquire stability through duplet and octet configuration. Octet rule means 8 valence electrons in valence shell of an atom. These 8 or 2 valence electrons gives stability to the atom as present in ideal gases

Octet Rule manifested in Table salt

The formula of table salt is NaCl



Na atom



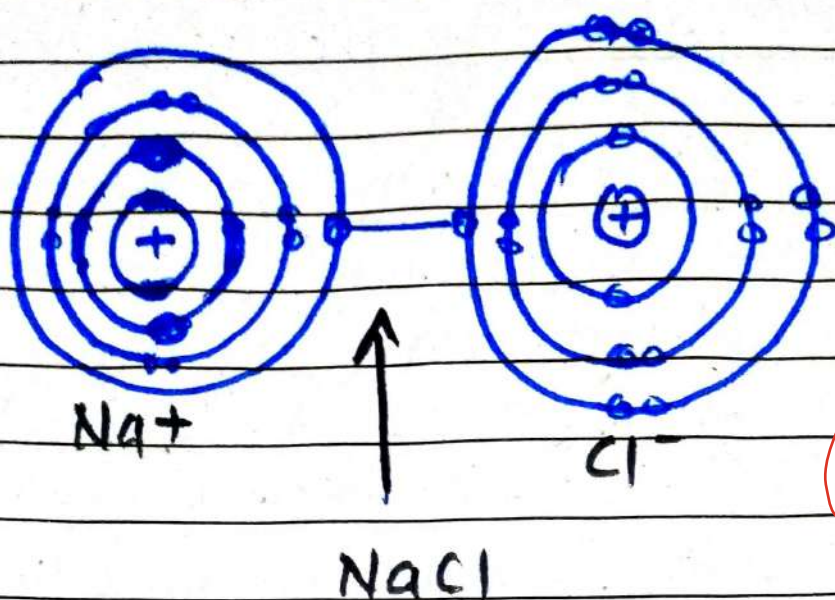
Sodium will lose outer most electron to get 8 valence electrons in 2nd shell

Cl atom



Chlorine atom gains electron from Sodium and complete its 8 electron from $7e^-$





Here electron is transferred from Sodium to chlorine.

Sodium loses to form Na⁺ with 8 e⁻ in valence shell, similarly chlorine accepts electron from sodium and form Cl⁻ and completes its valence shell (octet configuration).

Resultantly, NaCl (Table salt) forms.

Uses of Microwave in daily life

- (1) Used in microwave oven in heating, food, cooking and baking
- (2) Used in wireless communication
- (3) Used in wifi, bluetooth communication
- (4) Used in weather forecasting
- (5) Used in Traffic management, speed and direction of vehicle detection
- (6) used in high-bandwidth communication, such as Radar, Satellite and sonar

Uses of Radio waves in daily life

- (1) Used in Radio, Television and wireless communication
- (2) Used in satellites and Radars
- (3) Used by NASA from Mars to enable communication with earth
- (4) Used in cell-phone connection by micro-chips
- (5) used in wifi and bluetooth connectivity

Uses of x-rays in daily life

- (1) Used in ^{medical} imaging of body to detect stones, fracture, bone deformations, bone displacement and foreign body in body of human being.
- (2) Used in Non-destructive test (NDT)
- (3) Used to destroy tumor and cancer cell in cancer treatment
- (4) Used to detect abnormality in chest such as buffalo heart, lung collapse, pneumonia, consolidation, T-B (tuberculosis) and pneumothorax

Keyboard: Types numbers, letters and signs

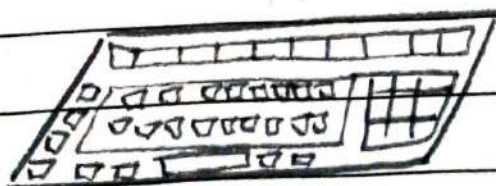
Mouse:

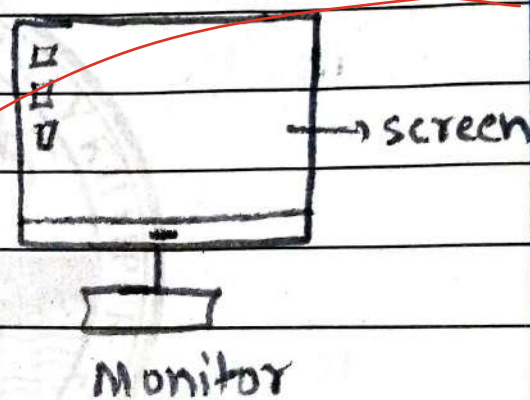

Human Eye

Human eye is a delicate and complex ^{organ} ~~part~~ consisting of many parts.

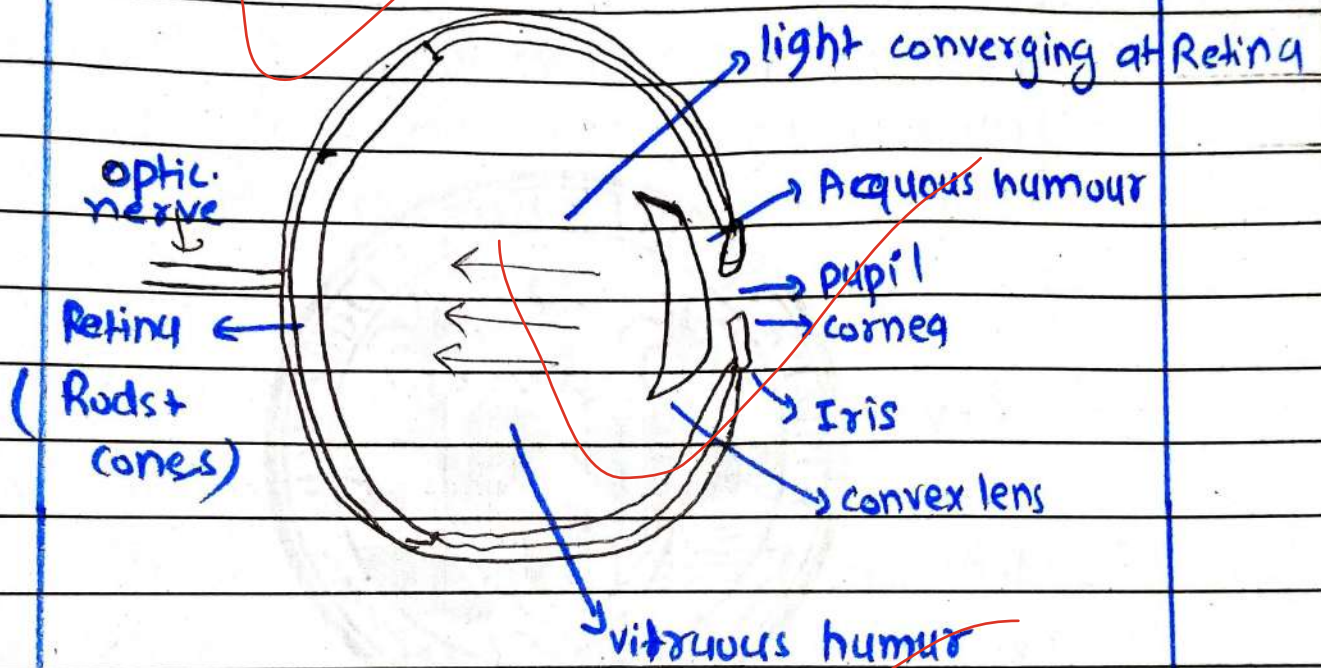


Diagram of eye

Cornea :

Cornea is a transparent, part of eye at front side. It refracts light waves towards retina and protect internal eye from dust, germs, and extreme environment.

Pupil;

Pupil is smaller opening in front of eye that allows light signals inside. It converges and diverges according to intensity of light. Surrounding the pupil, are muscles called iris that accommodate pupil. At higher intensity, (converges) pupil converges and low intensity light and dim light it diverges to enhance visibility.

Convex lens

It is a flexible, circular type lens, convex in shape; present at front side behind cornea. Convex lens converges light signals towards retina.

Retina;

Retina is highly sensitive layer present at behind surface of eyeball. It consists of photosensitive cells called rods and cones. Retina receives light signals and converts them into electrical signals and send towards brain via optic nerve.

(d)

Causes of Water Pollution

Water pollution is the addition of physical or chemical pollutants into waters that reduce its quality.

- (1) Industrial chemicals dumped into rivers, oceans, and lakes
- (2) Percolation of liquid pollutants through soil into underground water
- (3) Addition of solid wastes into water, such as plastics, domestic wastes, and glass.
- (4) Mixing of wasteful water with clean water, causes water pollution
- (5) Chemical factories like pesticides, fertilizers, pharmaceuticals, cosmetic, and cement industries dump waste into water openly
