Current Challenges of Pakistan's Economy & Measures to address.

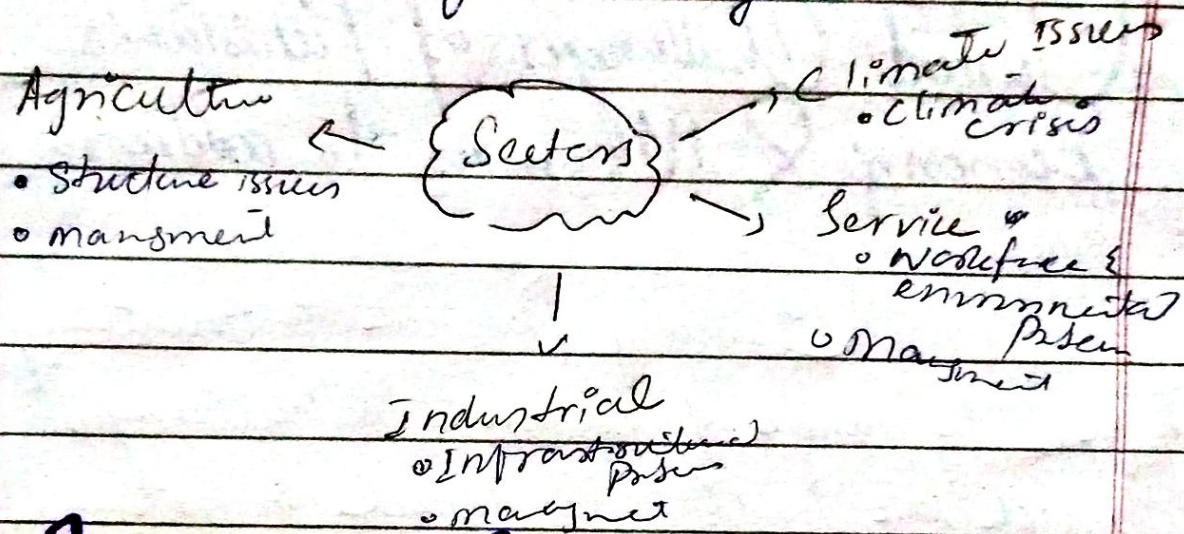

2024.

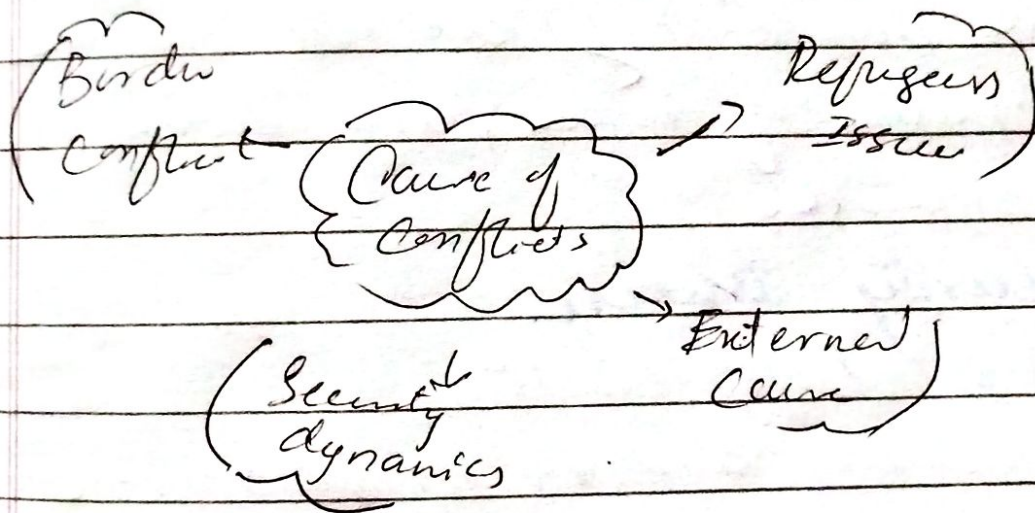
Issues remained complicated as earlier.

In 2023 act by Pakistan,
it was decided to remove all
the unregistered foreigners from
Pakistan. So Afghan refugees were
supposed to leave the country. But
the neighbor country did not consider
the nature of issue, and relations
got strained.

Security Issues

Both countries have
strained ties and the major concern
is security dynamics. Many groups
are functioning operating in Afghanistan,
that are threatening the peace of
Pakistan such as Tehreek-e-Taliban
Pakistan working network with
Taliban in Afghanistan. In 2022
Pakistan set airstrikes against them
and so the Afghan left in 2023.

In 2025 again conflict arose which
approached ceasefire in Oct, 2025 by

mediation of Qatar & Turkey.

Regional realignment

Both countries are long allies, such as Afghanistan mostly get assistance from India while operating against Pakistan. This factor has also affected bilateral ties.

Critical Analysis

Relation of Pakistan and Afghanistan has a strained picture since 2021, due to reason related to border, security and diplomacy. Along with it, mutual distrust between public and leadership exist, which has further spoiled the ties.

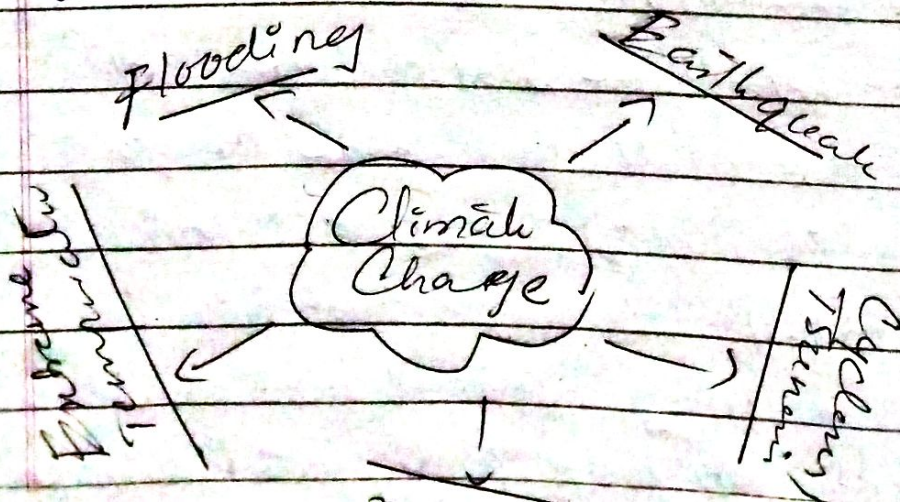

Smog & Pollution:

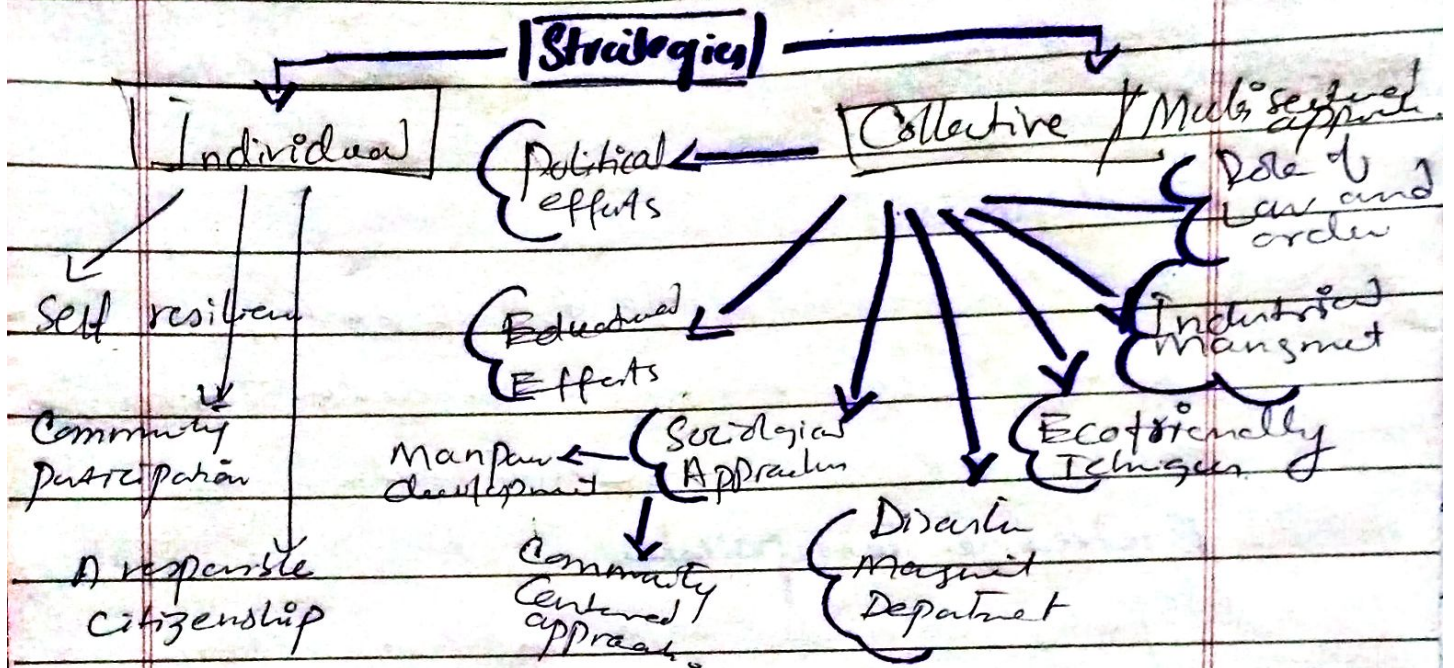
Due to air pollution caused by industries and transport Patistan commonly go through the issue of smog every year.
