2) Unity and Brotherhood.

When the entire community worships one God, it develops a strong bond of Ummah. This unity transcends geographic and ethnic divisions.

"Indeed, this Ummah of yours is one Ummah, and I am your Lord, so worship Me."
(Surah-Al-Ahbiya, 92:92)

3) End of Exploitation and Injustice.

Tauheed rejects the idea of human sovereignty and man-made hierarchies. When Allah alone is the Lawgiver, no man can oppress another. Islamic law, therefore rests on divine justice (Adl).

4) Establishment of Peace and Order.

A society governed by Tauheed-based principles promotes compassion, honesty, and collective welfare (Maslahah). It eradicates corruption and moral decay by anchoring every institution to divine accountability.
