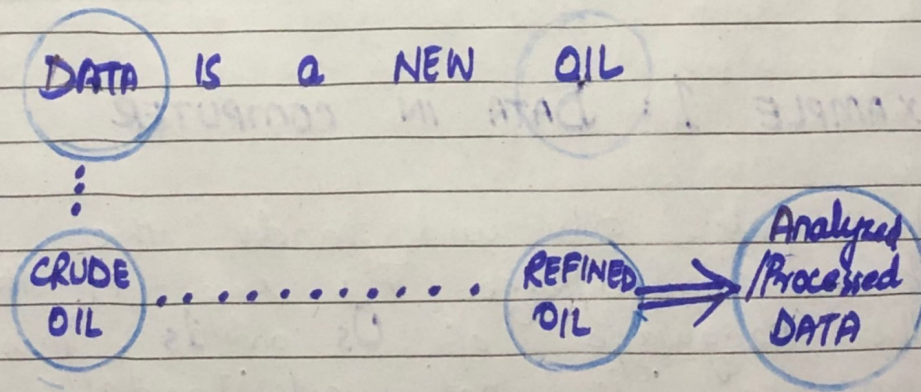

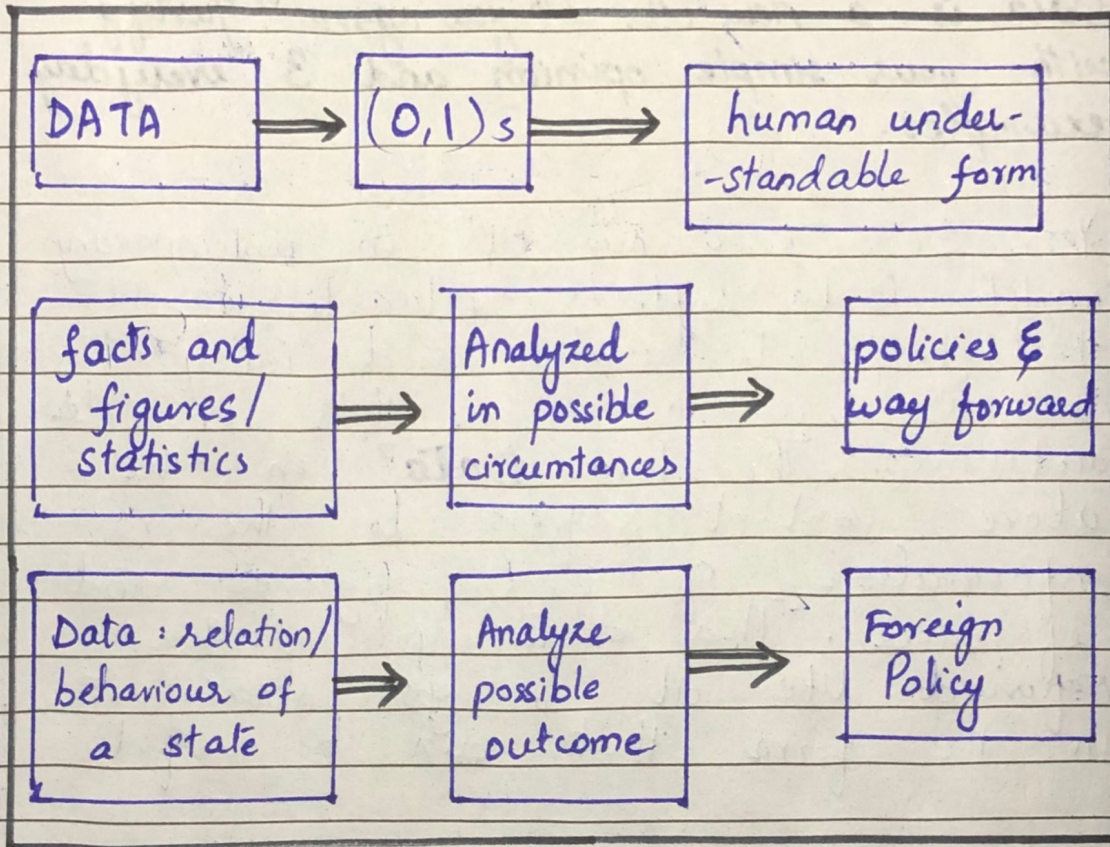


This diagram illustrates that Data is the crude form of oil. This data will be processed i.e. analyzed by scholars and analysts to convert it in the form of valuable information.

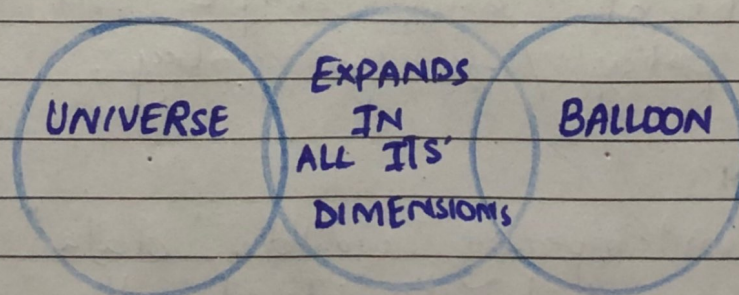

This, the expansion of universe is resemble to the blowing of balloon in three-different manners.

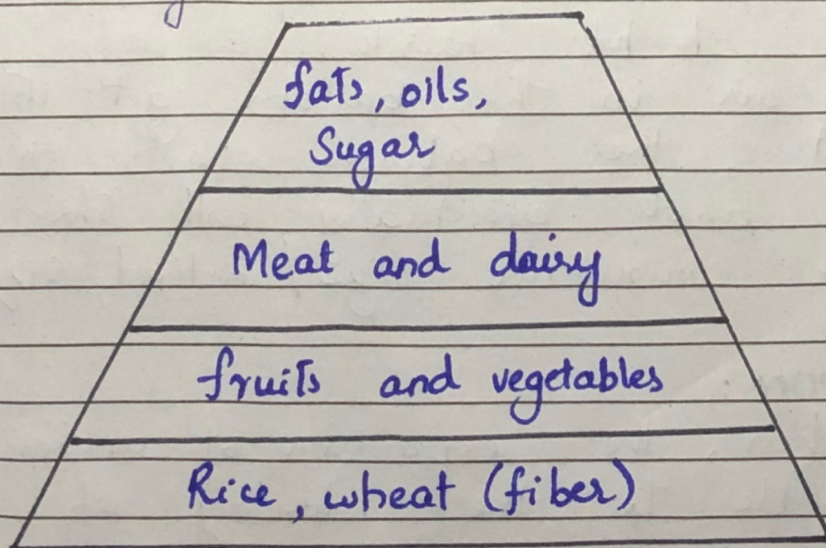

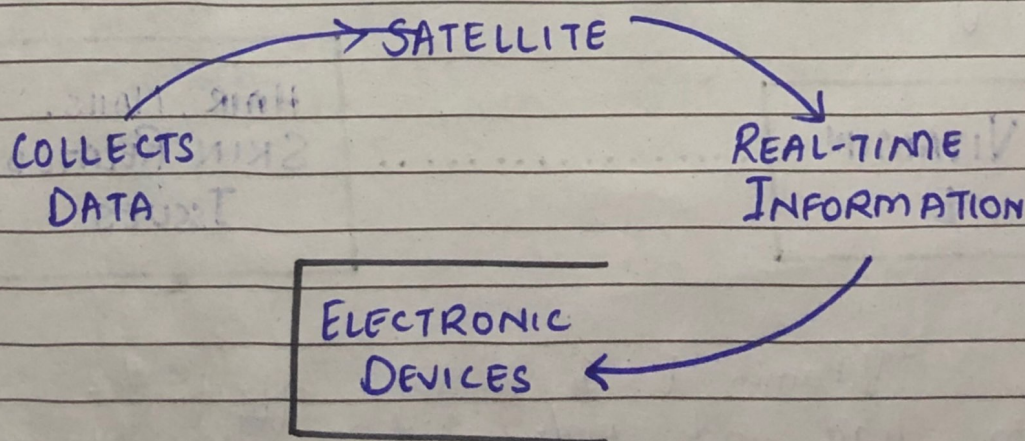

FUNCTION OF MITOCHONDRIA:

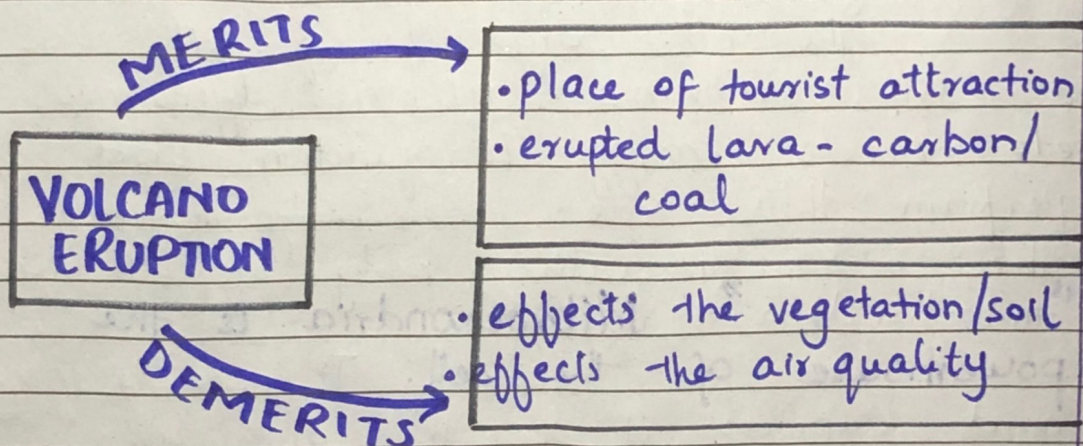

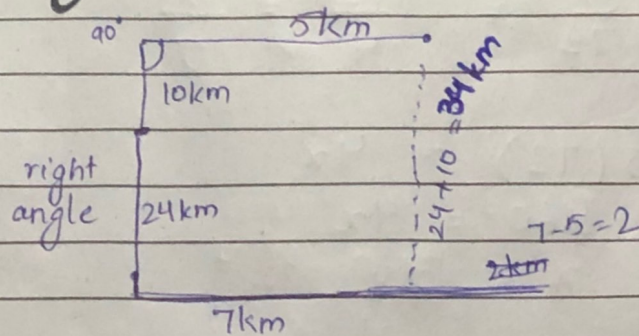
