Title : Renewable Energy and Sustainability

Renewable energy is widely considered as humanity's remedy for climate change, with promise of carbon neutrality and sustainable future. However, this optimism masks significant environmental and social costs. Technologies like solar panels, wind turbines and electric vehicles batteries rely on the extraction of rare earth minerals, cobalt and lithium which devastates ecosystems and displaces vulnerable communities in resource rich but impoverished regions. Electric vehicle battery production emits substantial carbon has limited life spans and creates recycling challenges. On the other hand, wind and solar infrastructure eventually ended into toxic waste. Moreover, the production and maintenance of these clean technologies still depend on fossil fuels. Thus green revolution though marketed as sustainable, often sustain cycle of extraction, pollution and ecological harm. True environmental progress requires restraint efficiency and humility rather than industrial exploitation disguised as a moral virtue.
