7- Do not add new idea or point in Conclusion

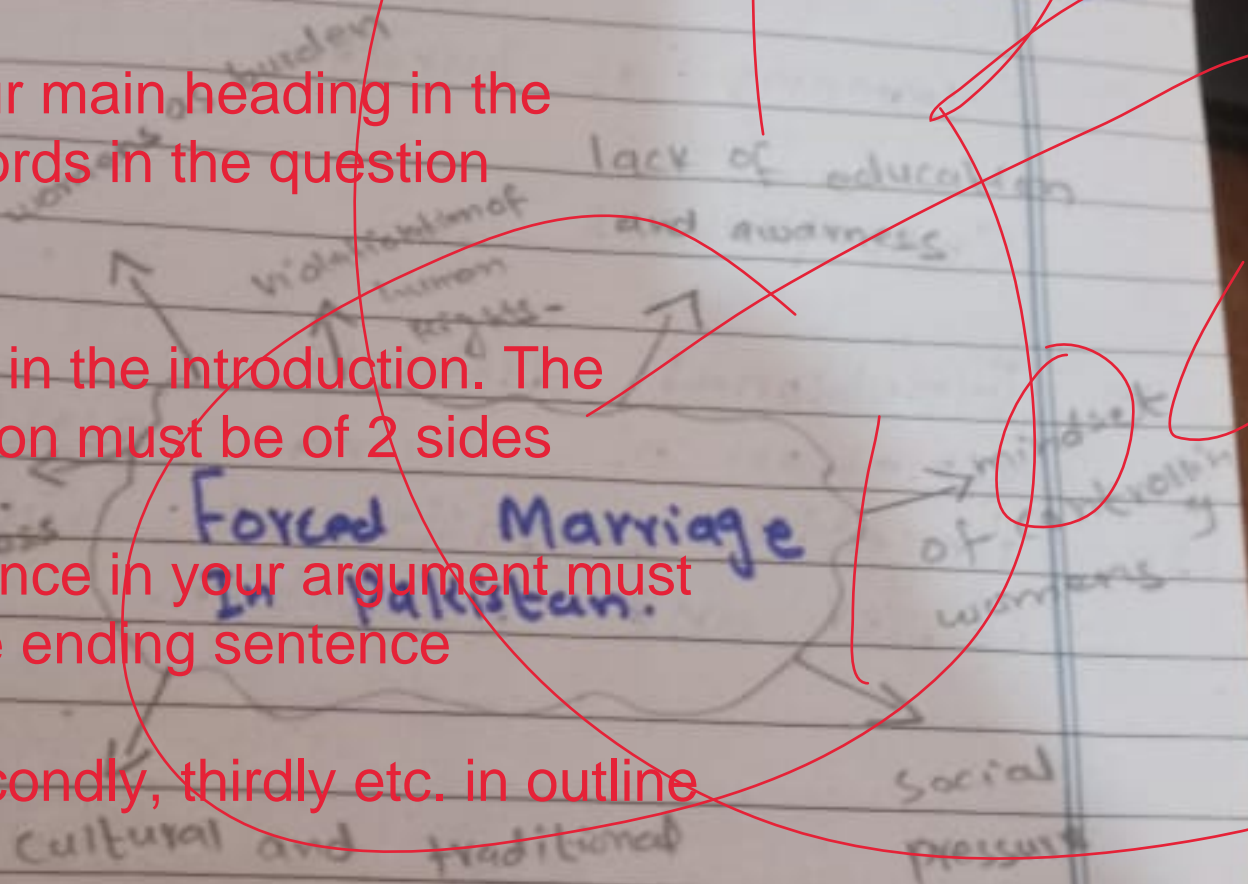
8- You won't pass the essay if make more than 4-5 grammatical mistakes
