**Allama Iqbal:**

Allama Iqbal in his renowned book: "Reconstruction of religious faith in Islam," poignantly asserts:

**Maulan Maududi:**

Maulan Maududi in his book "Towards Understanding Islam" says:

"Islam sustains on five pillars,



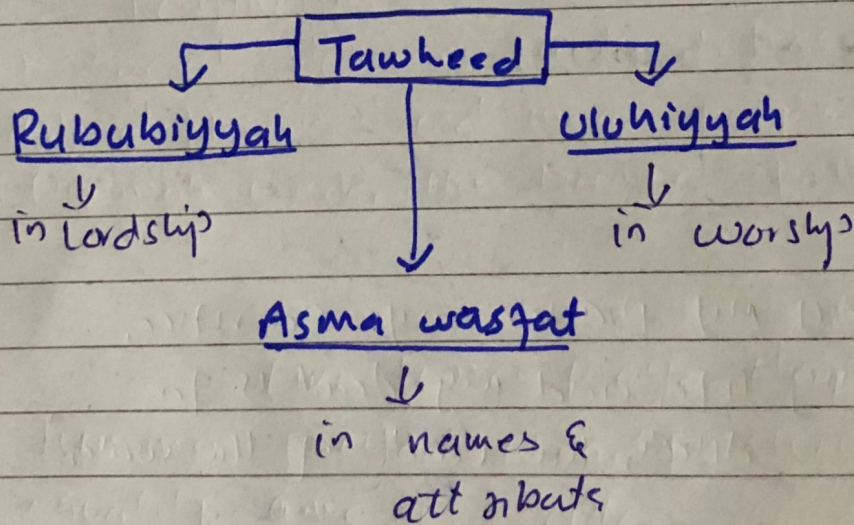
and one the pillars is to testify that there is no god except Allah

Tawheed plays a significant role in a human life:

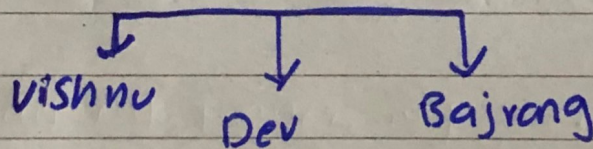

→ Therefore, it is imperative to show wrong concepts of Atheism, Polytheism and animism, one should embrace the belief of Tawheed.

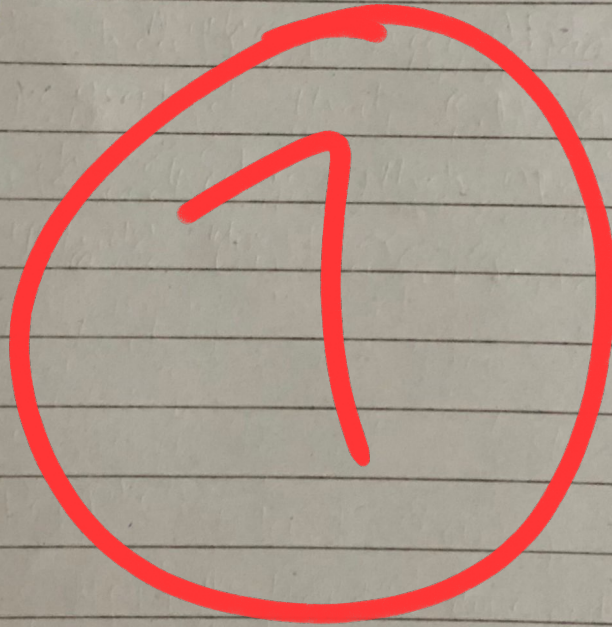
Karen Armstrong says:

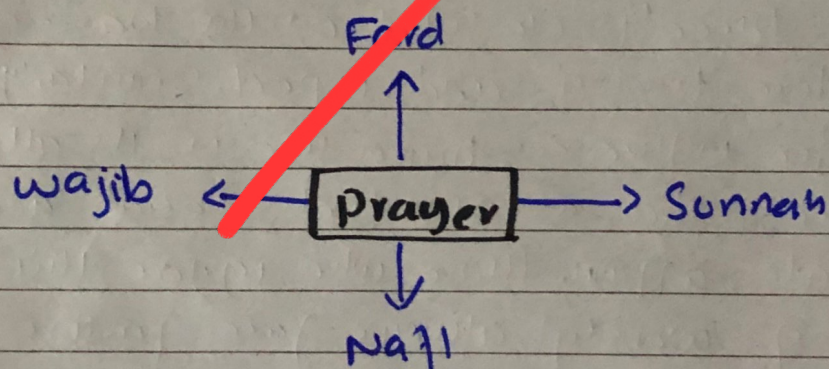

"Prayer means an act to bow down in reverence and communicate with Allah."

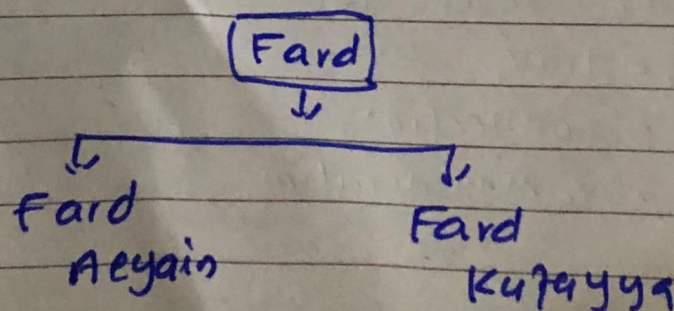
### III. Enlisting Categories of Prayer:

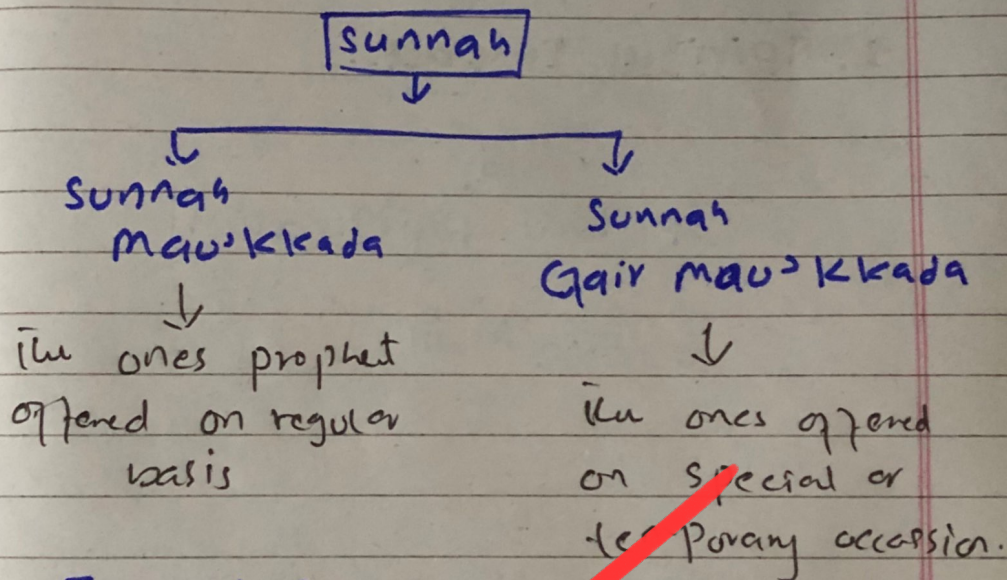

offered by prophet on various occasions.

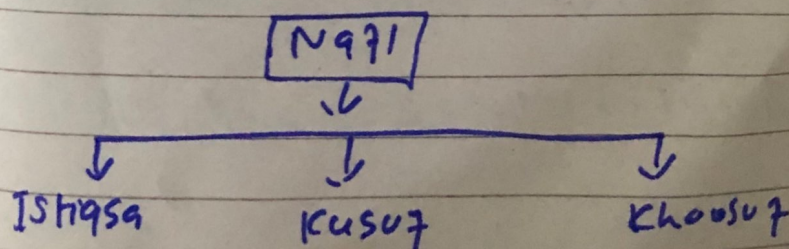
