Corruption in charity organization is another problem. In charity organizations, their is internal fraud like false expenses and misuse of charity, which is used for

personal use. External fraud like false invoicing which is submitting fake invoice to receive charity and unauthorized fundraising which ~~is~~^{are} scams that solicit donations without being affiliated to /with legitimate charity.

Terrorism fundraising is also acting like a poison. Charities, especially those operating overseas, are vulnerable to their funds being misused for terrorism financing.

All of the above shows how a charity that only include heart and intentions is acting like a sweet poison and eating away the poor's talent, potential and corruption, begging industries ~~is~~^{are} increasing.
