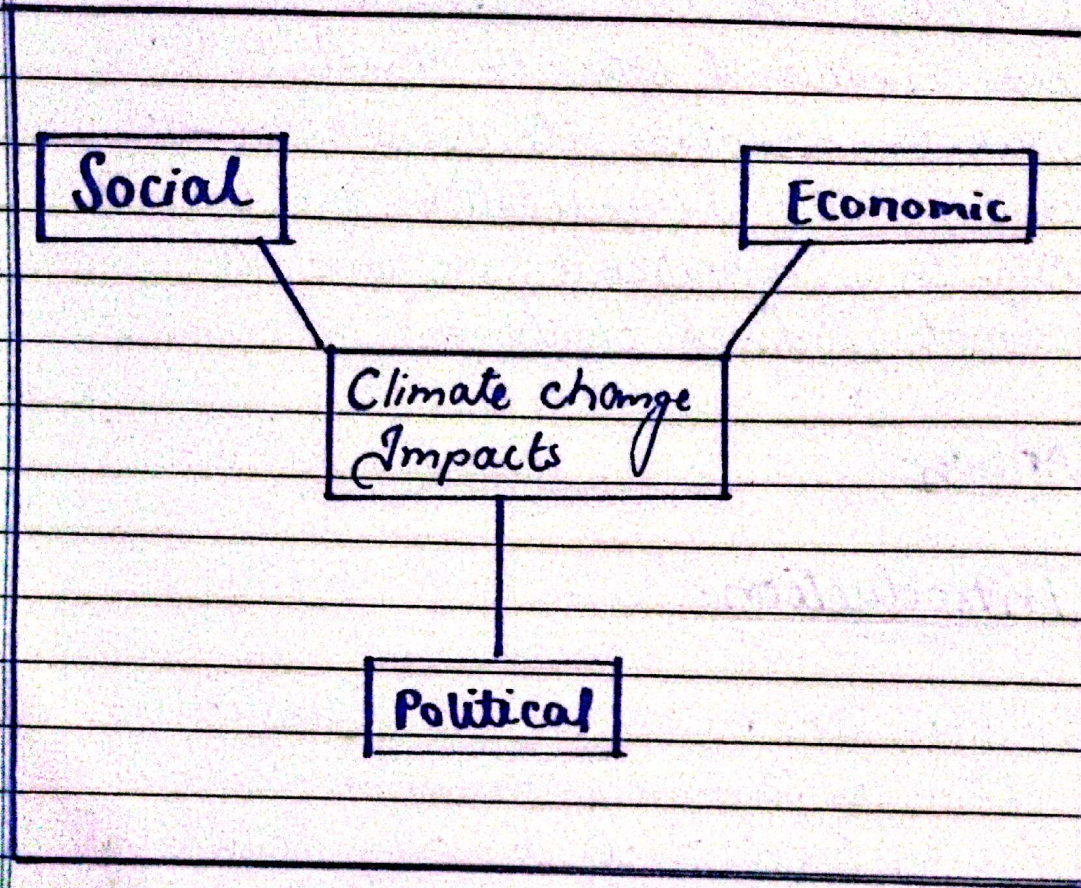
Answer.
