Gaza peace plan and the
Chances of it's Success — Islamabad's
policy and possible fallout on Pak.

Introduction.

US president Donald Trump proposed a peace plan for Gaza to end the bloody conflict between Israel and Palestine ongoing after 7 October 2023 incident. According to this plan, a **Regional Stabilization Force (RSF)** should be established to run Gaza's day to day affairs. It is recommended that **Pakistan** will provide military force to establish RSF in addition to other muslim State's forces. The territory of **Palestine**, moreover, Watched by **USA and Israel** and RSF will be answerable to them. Many muslim states gave Consent over this peace proposal except to disarm the **Hamas**.

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Disarmament is a Constituent factor of this Gaza peace plan by using Regional Stabilization force **Islamabad** shows the agreement over this plan but take a clear stance to not participate in Hamas disarmament. This thing spread chaos not only at national level but also disturb the relations of Pakistan with other muslims state as this peace plan is ambiguous over **"Two State solution"**.

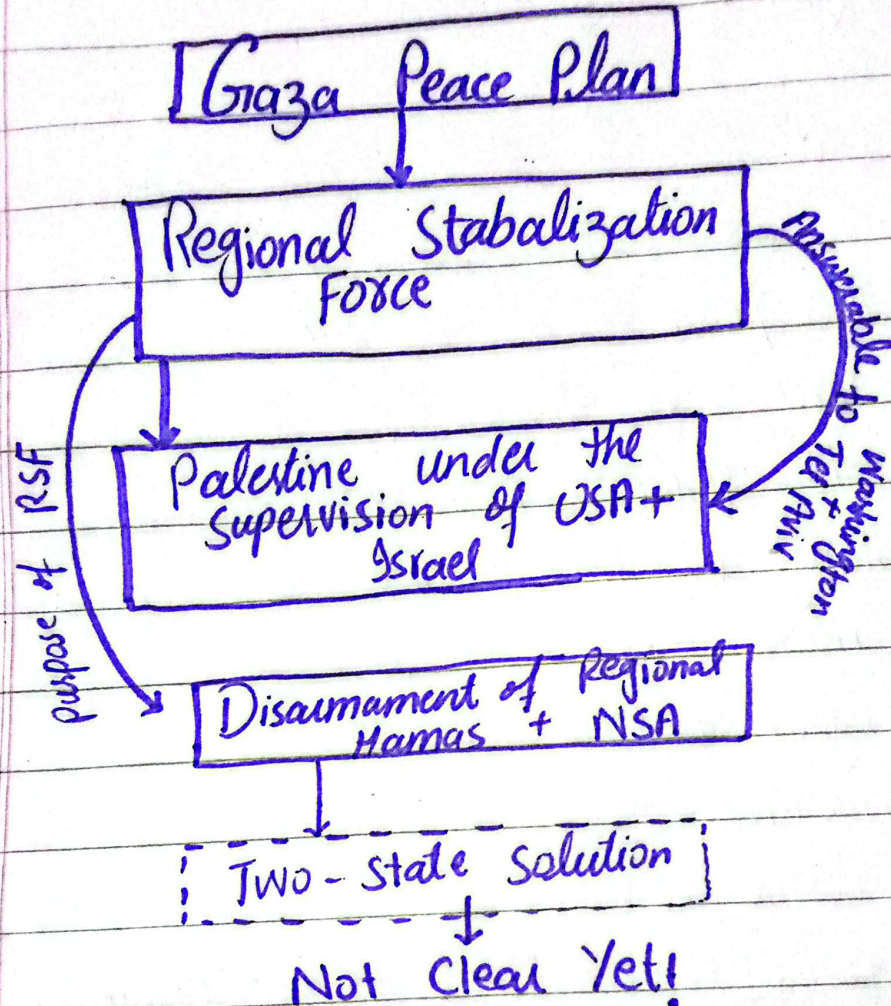
Gaza Peace Plan :

After a truce brokered by USA, Donald Trump proposed a peace plan for Gaza. **Regional Stabilization force RSF** with the collaboration of Islamic military forces e.g Pakistan and to watch Palestine's affairs, it will be a responsibility of **USA and Israel**. This peace plan clearly define to disarm the Hamas and other non-state actors but ambiguous

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about "Two state solution" between Israel and Hamas.



→ Critical Evaluation Over Gaza plan
No Chances of Two-State Solution:-

According to this plan, there is no any chance of two-state solution that provide Sovereignty to Palastinian people and guard their territorial integrity. Although, **UNSC** clearly

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mentioned, **48%** Palestinian territory,
51% for Israel and **1%** independent
region of **Jerusalem**.

Muslim forces against Hamas and other NSA:

This peace plan suggest a muslim
force to disarm the Hamas and
other regional Non-State actors. This
thing will rise the hostility and spread
chaos across the region as a conflict
began between muslims ^{forces} against
muslims Jihadist.

Disarmament — Not possible:

The ultimate goal of Hamas is
a "**Free Palestine**" and this peace
plan has no clue of two state
solution. Therefore, it is not easily
possible for **RSF** or any other
forces to disarm Hamas. As a
result this peace plan will
never bring the dreamy results
for muslims or Palestine.

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Fragile Truce - Violation by Israel :-

The existing truce between Israel and Palestine is extremely fragile as the world witnessed it has been violating by Israel since the Cease Fire occurred in October 2025. More than 500 people were died after this truce in different skirmishes between Hamas and Israel.

Trump. Netanyahu - Dec 2025 meeting :-

In December 2025, Trump gave a warm welcome to Israeli prime-minister Netanyahu. After this meeting according to International Media, Trump announced to adopt harsh policy against Hamas if Hamas show any resistance to disarm itself.

USA's Coercive policy further escalate the tension in the Middle East.

Policy of Islamabad:

Support the RSF development.

Pakistan align its policy as to support the development of regional development force and announce to provide military support to stabilize peace in the region.

Against to Disarm the Hamas:

Foreign minister of Pakistan Khwaja Asif reiterated as: "It is not our duty to disarm the Hamas and other NSA."

Force to implement UN Resolution:

Pakistan reminds the world there is only — UN resolution of "Two state Solution" — way to develop peace in the hostile region. An independent, autonomous and sovereign, self govern palestine will end this bloody war permanently.

Possible fallout on Pak:

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A Step towards the recognition of Israel:

If Pakistan will join RSF in its present conditions, it will be a step towards to join **Abraham accord**.

Therefore, it is necessary for Islamabad to reject this peace plan or RSF plan.

According to **M. Ali Jinnah**:

"Pakistan will never recognize Israel until, a Free Palestinian State emerge over the world map."

Relation's with Muslim States:

Since it is against the objectives of an autonomous Palestine, therefore, the relations between Pakistan and other muslim states should strained.

National Instability:

As the people of Pakistan Consider Palestine as a Holy Land and attach with it emotionally and Spiritually. Therefore any stance or action against

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The fighting groups for Free Palestine should spread chaos, hostility, in the region and hurt the prestige of national stability.

Conclusion:

Gaza peace plan to ensure stability in the Middle East and end a destructive, deteriorating and bloody war in Palestine. Proposed suggestions, in this regard, by USA to develop RSF is another tactic by USA and Israel to control the Palestine through muslims community. It will have negative consequences over Pakistan's regional stability if it ready to join RSF in present conditions. Therefore, Islamabad align its policy accordingly and denied to assist or disarm the Hamas. But ready to provide any military assistance to develop peace in the region for other peaceful purposes such as rebuild the Gaza.

Introduction:

Pakistan and Saudi-Arabia Signed a defence pact in **September 2025** aiming to Strengthen their defence system under the umbrella of Pakistan's nuclear Capabilities. **International media i.e Al-Jazeera, BBC, CNN** termed this defence pact as a **Muslim NATO**. Pakistan's Prime minister invited other muslim states to Join this defence pact. It's a great **geopolitical achievement** for both states as this pact undermine the sole hegemony of **Israel** in Middle-East as a nuclear power. Similarly, it's an alarming

situation for New Delhi significantly after 10 May-stand off. Pakistan through this deal become the part of KSA 2030 vision as said by **Muhammad Bin Suleman**. Saudi Arabia will provide assistance militarily and technologically to Pakistan to strengthen the bi-lateral cooperations.

Pak-Saudi Defence Pact:

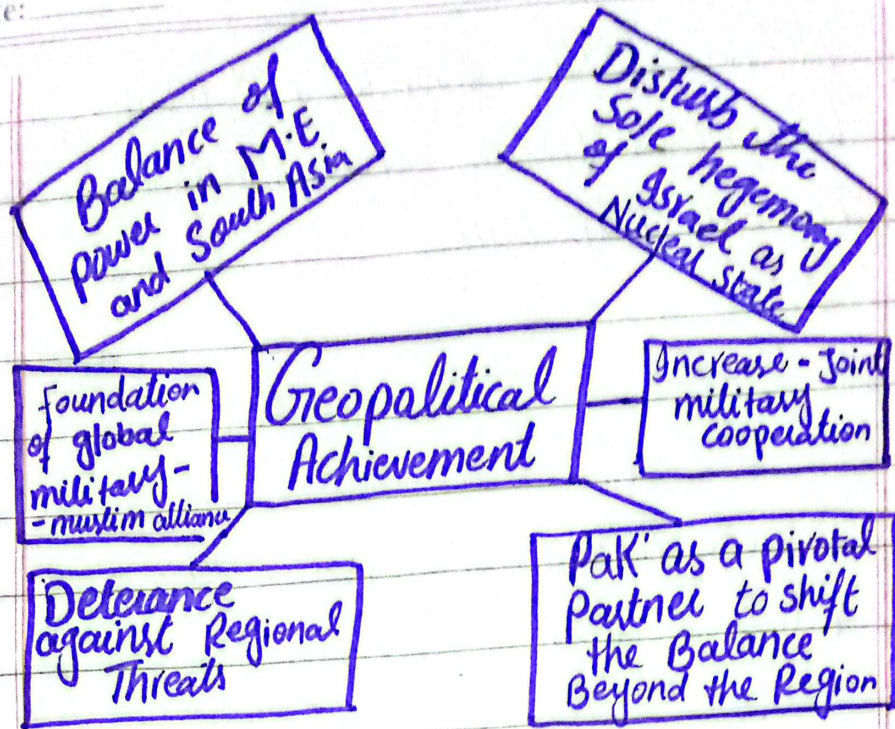
Pakistan and Saudi Arabia signed a defence pact in September 2015. According to this pact, both states reiterated as:

"Attack on one state should consider as an attack on another state."

Therefore it is a significant achievement for both states. Under this agreement, both KSA and Pakistan disturb the **"Balance of power" (BOP)** in their respective region.

of a Sovereign state. Therefore, this

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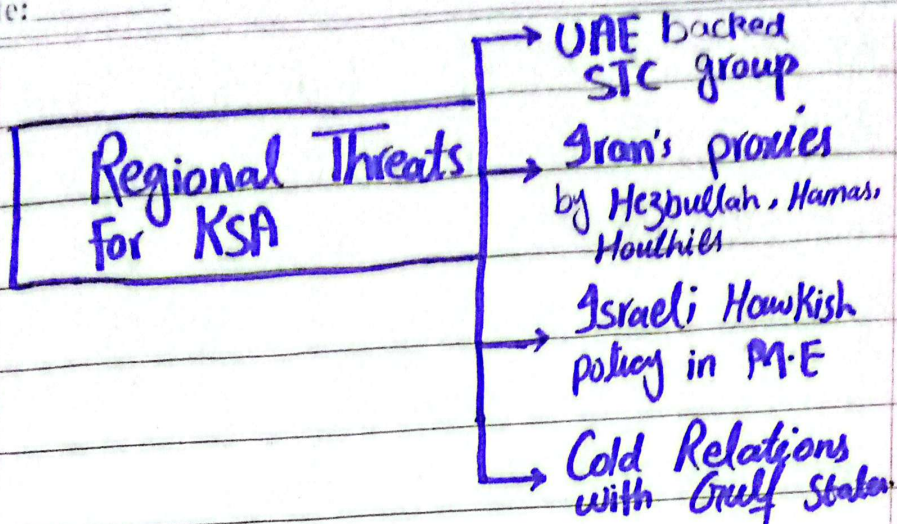
defence pact provide a deterrence to Saudi Arabia, under Pakistan's nuclear capability.

Deterrence Against Regional Threat : (For KSA)

Saudi Arabia has not cordial relations with **Gulf States** especially **UAE**. Similarly Iran's support to Non-State actors in Middle-East e.g. **Houthies, Hamas** develop a strain relations of KSA with Tehran. UAE Support to **Southern Transitional Council (STC)** in Yaman, is a security threat across the Southern border of Saudi Arabia. **KSA** never wants to spread the **Shia's influence** by Iran in Arabian peninsula. Against all these regional threats, this pact act as a deterrence for Saudi Arabia.

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Deterrence against Regional Threats (For Pak)

For Pakistan, this defence pact is provide defence against regional threats. After Pakistan - India May 10 conflict, the situation in South Asia develop a hostile environment. As India's PM Said:

“It is Just a pause of Operation Sindoor and the conflict may arise at any time”

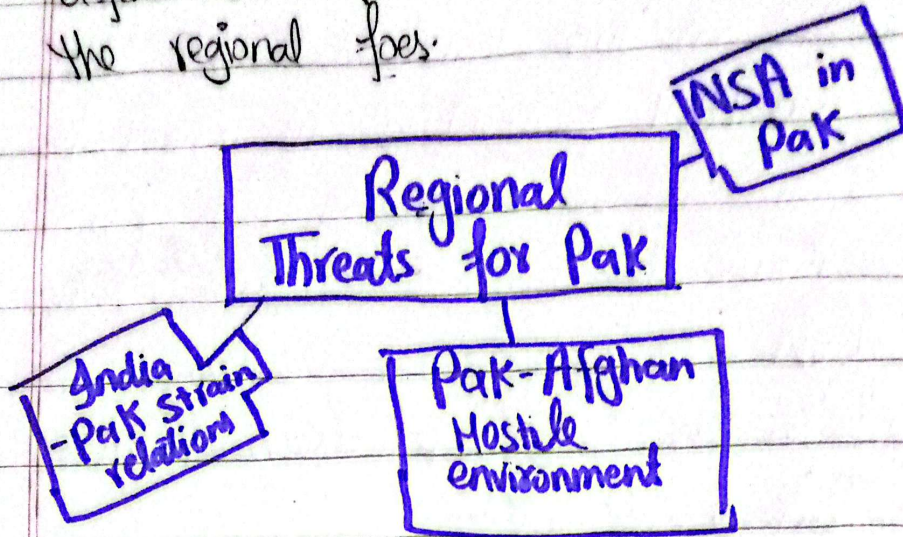
Similarly, at Western border, Pakistan faces a wave of militant insurgency in the Year 2025.

⇒ Economic Opportunities for Pak

Pakistan get a great achievement after signing this pact in terms of economy. Saudi Arabia agreed on the following deals with Pakistan:

Saudi-Vision of 2030

Saudi Arabia added Pakistan in its vision of 2030. According to this vision, Saudi Arabia will spread its economic influence by increasing trade across the region. Moreover,

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it is a pathway to attain a Sustainable development in KSA irrespective to solely depending on Oil reserves. and now Pakistan is getting support for development.

Joint Military Cooperation:

Saudi Arabia provide intelligence and military assistance to Pakistan under this pact. Joint military exercises, Weapons supply, enhance trading in various military sectors, Pakistan's military force allocation for the protection of two muslim's Holy cities e.g. Makkah and Madinah are all under this deal that is an excellent economic achievement for Pakistan.

Conclusion:

Pakistan and Saudi Arabia's defence pact act as a great geopolitical achievement for both states and economic achievement for Pakistan. It act as a deterrence against regional threats for Saudi Arabia in

Russia and NATO have opposite stance over end of Ukraine's War — USA has different stance

Introduction:

Russia and NATO have opposite stance over the end of Ukraine's War as Russia's motives are to never allow Ukraine to join NATO, never return the annexed land to Ukraine, and stop the supply of military armaments from NATO to Ukraine. But on the other hand NATO has strong motive to forbid the Russian presence at their door steps. Therefore they are using **Coercive approaches** i.e. freezing the Russian assets and use them to provide military aids to Ukraine, Sanctions on Russian oil to force it for a longlasting Truce. Moreover, They are demanding a withdrawal of Russian forces from the annexed 20%.

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Territory of Ukraine. In this complex situation, USA - leader of NATO Alliance take a different stance that is mostly supporting the Russia. By keeping in view the present circumstances, there is a dire need to stop this war as ISW warned the intensity of war has been accelerating since last year after the Russian 2022-Feb invasion.

Black sea is a choke point for Russian trade to access the Western market. but Ukraine has control over this trade route according to maritime trade rules of International law. Therefore, the situation is going to worse over Russia and NATO different strategic interests.

NATO view as: Russia's Expansionist policy

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NATO alliance considered Russia's invasion in Ukraine as its expansionist policy. Therefore, they wanted to protect Russia, Ukraine and provide military joint assistance against Russia.

Bold Stance of Russia—due to Russia - China Alliance:

USA and European Countries put sanctions on Russian oil. But Russia's close relations with China to make their war machine stronger against Russia. Trade between China and Russia.
