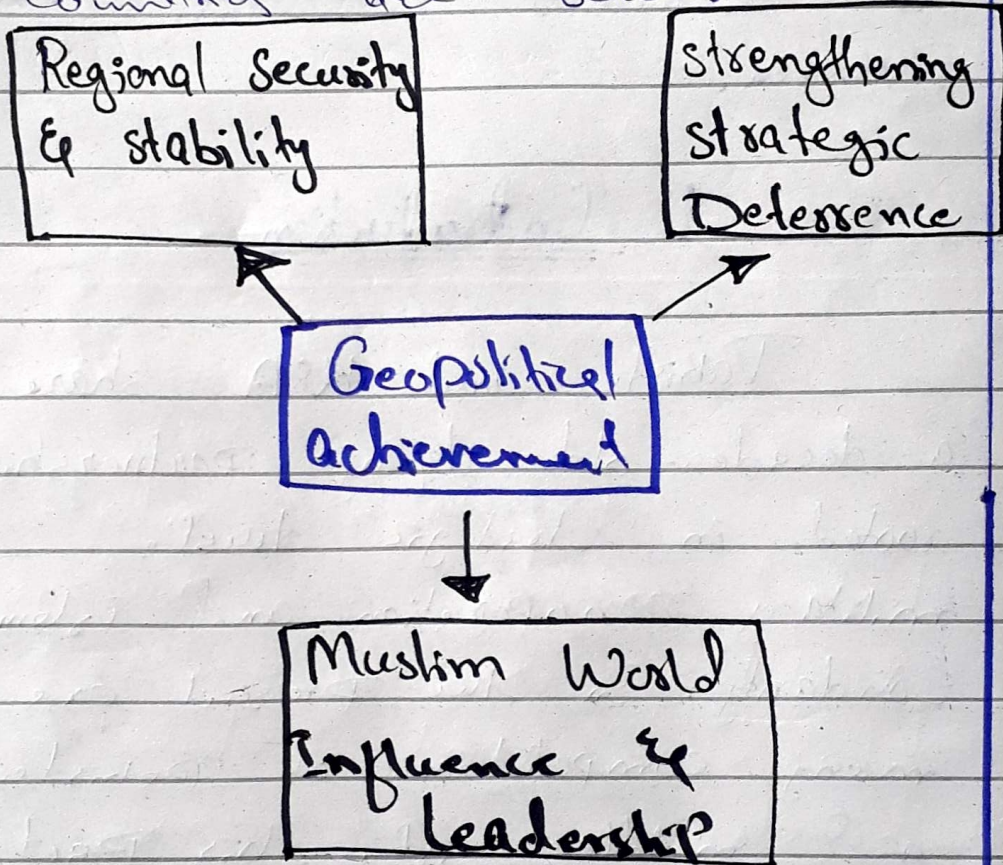
Pakistan-KSA Defense Pact would have far reaching geopolitical achievement for both the countries and economic opportunities for Pakistan.

C. Muslim world Influence and leadership

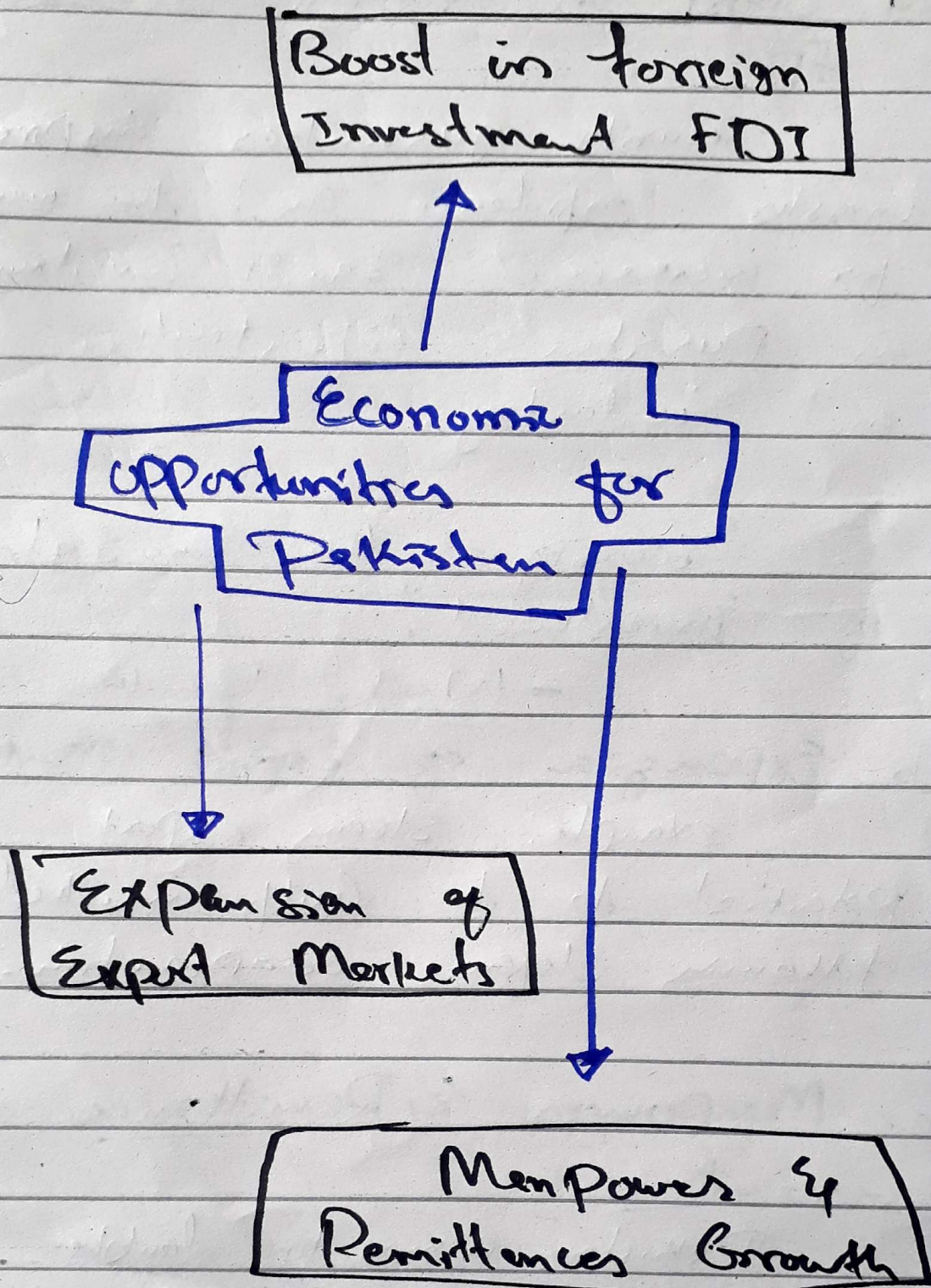
Influence, shaping Political priorities of Muslim states and collective diplomatic voices in OIC forums and Muslim geopolitics.

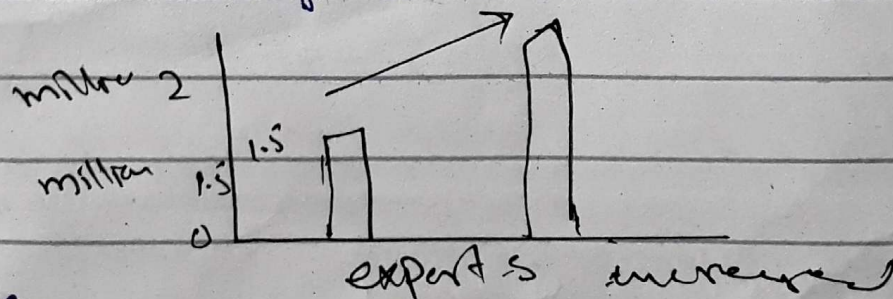
