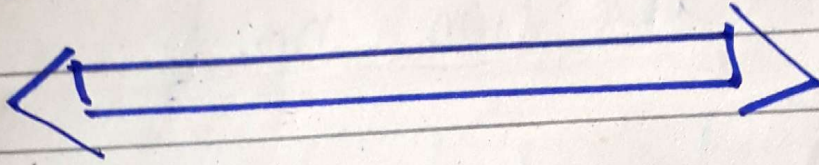
The minister addressing the gathering said, "my fellow citizens, we stand today at a critical juncture in our nation's history; we must ask ourselves,

the mistakes of the past. Let's move forward with determination and courage.



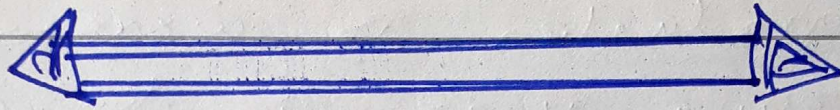

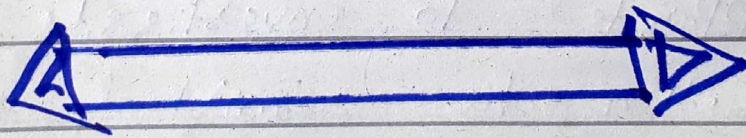

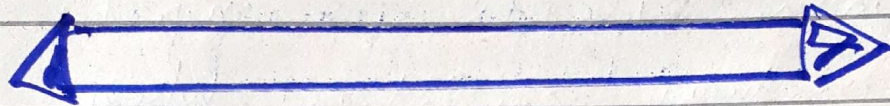
