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(4) Youth - out of country

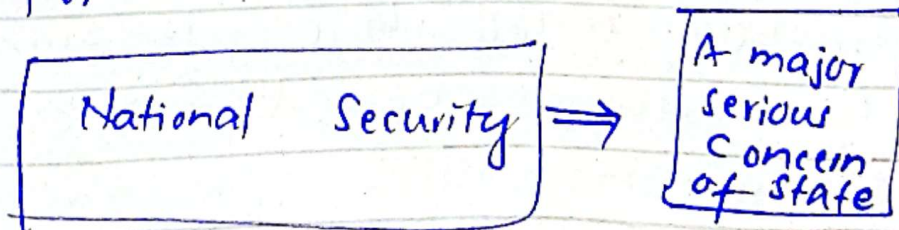

Another Serious Threat for Pakistan is Public Health that is the major rising issue for Pakistan.

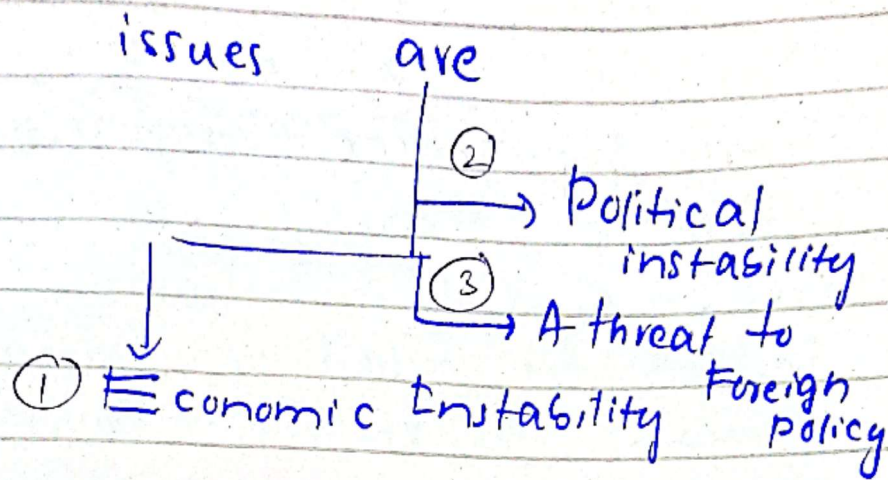
