1.6) Right of Honour:


“And he gives sovereignty to whom he can. And he takes sovereignty from whom he want to.” — Duran


2. Special rights are given to women in Islam:

2.1) Special relaxation from performing religious duties:


Special relaxation given to women from performing religious duties such as:

2.4) woman as a mother:


“Paradise lies under the feet of the mother.” — Holy prophet peace be upon him

3.1) Efforts at the state level:


The state is the sole organ to make sure that rights should be given to woman. By making laws and implementing these laws. Therefore, woman can get her rights in a proper way.

3.2) Efforts at the community level:


In community, religious scholars play a vital role to engage with community and provide guidance to the community for giving rights to women.

1.2.6) Islamic civilization is based on the principle of hope:


"Surely with hardship there is ease."


Allah has stated in the holy Quran that suicide is highly prohibited in Islam. Therefore, for social welfare suicide is prevented in Islam.
