- 1- Aqeed-e-Tauheed (means, strong belief in Allah)
- 2- Aqeed-e-Risalat (Belief in prophet hood)
- 3- Aqeed-e-Akhirat (Belief in Here-after)

All belief strengthen the faith of an individual, make him a dignified man, he become a man of high moral character, he never become hopeless, neither is he afraid of any thing except Allah, true believers also fulfill all of their duties toward society as well as they know Allah is looking at them it create a sense of equality Responsibility and sense of accountability toward one's society.

→ Aqeeda-e-Tauheed:

Aqeed is derived from Arabic word aqad - which mean strong belief and complete trust in teaching of a Religion, while Aqeeda tauheed

means a strong belief in Allah that Allah is the Creator, Powerful, Sustainer and Eternal.
