Thus, by assuring development projects people can feel connected and part of the country. Equal development of provinces is necessary to assure people do not face inequalities in their day to day lives. As even minor inequalities could roll up into highs with passage

of time. Thus, power plants, schools, university, roads, railways and hospitals should be equally provided to the province. Ensuring basic needs in the province should be prime goal of the government. Moreover, these goals should be long lasting, and should not be impacted with the change of government.
