For instance, in Afghanistan, 40% of the population is living under poverty (United Nations, Afghanistan Report, 2025). This has given rise to the children working in clothing factories and selling and shipment industry in Afghanistan. Therefore, due to the issue of economic condition of the country, child labour is usually a neglected phenomenon in most of the countries around the world.~~

As the families of poor children are already in debt, the children are easily available to work in factories and mining sector. The places where adults don't want to work due to the fear of harm to their lives, childrens easily work due to the economic conditions of their families. As children don't have a say in their families, they are usually ignored and forced to work in factories and mining sector. For instance, in the fields of Balochistan, for mining usually children are taken from the tribal areas, as they are easily available to work in hazardous areas as well. Hence, the ease of availability of children to work in hazardous areas also contribute to the rise of child labour appearing as a neglected issue in the contemporary world.

Apart from the ease in finding the children as labourers, child labour is usually neglected ~~as~~ issue as children are

easy to be manipulate by the factories for lower wages. The children when hired as labourers are usually given lesser pay as they are under age and fear of getting caught working as labourer. This fear aids the factories to manipulate them to work in factories, mining and households for lesser pay than deserved. As the economic conditions of the children's families is not good, they also agree on lower wages. As the children work on lower wages, factories prefer to hire them and neglect the laws related to child labour in the country. According to the Global Political Review, children are usually hired by the factories for low wages and exploited by the owner due to its hidden and unprofessional nature which donot come under the control of the government. Therefore, child labour is usually a neglected assue as children are easy to manipulate and bargained for lower wages than adults.

In addition to the children as easy target for manipulation for lower wages, the lesser access of children to the educational resources is also a major reason for the child labour appearing as a norm in the society. The educational institutions are made far from the poor and tribal areas which result in the lesser access of

children to the educational resources in the world. The children who don't go to schools, as are free, are indulged in labouring activities by their families. For instance, in the poor areas of Africa, due to lack of accessibility to educational resources, children are indulged in the mining work in the country. Therefore, due to the lack of educational resources, the child labour remain as a neglected issue in the world.

Apart from the ~~lack~~ lack of access of children to educational opportunities, the normality of children working in the households is also resulting in the child labour appearing as a neglected issue in the society. The children, especially young girls are hired as domestic workers in families. Young minds when forced to work ~~for~~ since young age, ~~th~~ suffer from depression and anxiety in their lives. For instance, according to the Pakistan Social Sciences Review, there is a evidence that child labourers experience

physical injuries, mental distress and psychological trauma on young individuals. Therefore, child labour has a major impact on the mental and physical health of the children.

In addition to the negative impact on the mental and physical health of the individuals as child labourers, the child labour also results in the loss of educational opportunities of children working as labourers. The children working as child labourers are usually sent to earn when their ages to gain education. The child labour is preferred by the families than the education of these young individuals. For instance, according to UNICEF, 238 million individuals are currently working as child labourers around the world. (UNICEF, Child Labour Report, 2024) This means that these 238 million children have lost their access to the education from such a young age. Therefore the negligence of child labour has resulted in the loss of educational opportunities for the children.

Apart from the loss of education, the child labour has also increased the cruelty against the children working in the fields. The children working in factories and mines are usually not provided the basic labour facilities and therefore, their rights are manipulated due to their young age. For

instance, the labour right act of Pakistan, provides the clause of work hours and recommended salary of the labour, but in child labour these laws are not followed. In addition to it, the children are also beaten and remained hungry to impose more work onto them. As the children are weak, they cannot raise their voice against this cruel behavior. Hence, child labour result in the ~~even~~ cruelty against children working in factories and mines.

In addition to the cruelty against the child labourers, the child labour negligence also result in the increase in child rapes and sexual harassments. Young individuals when work in factories are usually harassed by the older workers and landlords. As the children are not aware of this issue they are easily manipulated and harassed.

Moreover, the young girls working in households also suffer from sexual harassment and rapes. due to their 'lax' voice impact on the adults. Therefore, the negligence of child labour issue has increased the ratio of the child rapes and sexual harassment against child labourers.

Your interpretation should be in depth, comprehensive and academic.

Always address the asked part. It should be evident in your outline, which should be self-explanatory in nature. Essays/Outlines that give related information without addressing the asked part do not qualify.

The whole essay should be relevant. Even if 1-2 arguments are irrelevant the essay will not pass.

Distribution of topic should be according to the demand of the topic statement i.e. if there is one scoring point it should be given more weight, if there are 2 or more scoring points all should be given equal weight.

All claims made in the essay must be substantiated. Out of 15-17 arguments at least 9-10 should be academically backed with proper references. The rest should be backed by either case studies or generally known information.

Evidence must be authentic and come from proper and authentic academic sources.

Newspapers do not qualify as an academic source. Illustrations and vague mentions of events do not qualify as academic evidence.

Essays that are lacking in evidence do not qualify.

LANGUAGE (25%)

Focus on enhancing your grammar as any essay with 4-5 grammatical mistakes does not pass.

Your essay must be in the tone and tense of the topic statements. Essays that fail to comply do not pass.

Your sentence structure should be simple, yet clear and diversified.

Vocabulary used should be simple, clear and concise. Expression should always be formal and academic.

You are never to write in 1st and 2nd person pronouns.

You must always use the given keywords and your topic for your thesis statements and main headings in your outline.

STRUCTURE (20%)

Your essay must follow the selected pattern and that structure should be maintained throughout.

INTRODUCTION: The introduction is the longest paragraph of the essay, at least 200 words. It should start with a hook, must give the glimpse of what's to come and must have a thesis statement. Besides hook, your introduction should not have any sort of information and reference. Avoid definitions in introduction.

BODY PARAGRAPHS: Approximately 150 words at most and all the body paragraphs must be consistent in length. Should follow the proper structure of an academic paragraph i.e. it must have a topic sentence, supporting point, evidence and concluding sentence. The topic sentence and concluding sentence must align with each other. There should be no new information in the concluding sentence. One paragraph represents one subheading in the outline and consists of one idea.

CONCLUSION: Must start with the concluding phrase. There should be no new information in the conclusion. It should recap the arguments. Conclusion does not have any examples and information. If you are ending it on a hopeful note, remember that solutions and hope are not the same.
