## Theoretical perspective of gendered crimes


According to various gendered theories, crimes are committed against women at highest rate, the perspective of theorist is that women believe they are weaker group, and vulnerable

they will less likely to protect themselves.


For the most such attitude affects women being victim of crimes.

# Measures to reduce gender-based crimes in Pakistan:



## Developing and reviewing laws to reduce gender based crimes:

The first measure to reduce the crime rate is the development of more effective laws and remodeling or reviewing existing laws to add new crime definitions in era of technology. These laws must cover all societal, cultural, workplace and cyber crimes against women with institutional measures for the reduction of crimes.

## Establishment of crime prevention force:

To implement legislations against gendered crimes, government must form crime prevention force exclusively for gendered crimes. It search for, assist and investigate

Crimes based on gender - Its department and offices should be separate from traditional policing.

## Activating crime-prevention centres and helplines:

Although, government has established helplines for female but this system is very ineffective due to lack of training, funding and no awareness about these programmes leading to high crime rate.

In 2015, in Punjab almost 250 cases of gender-based crimes were reported (Dawn).

For reduction of such crimes, it is crucial to establish crime prevention centres and helplines that provide 24/7 help to women on immediate bases at any place.

## Education and awareness through media

Media has effective role in promoting certain ~~perspectives~~, unfortunately ~~drawn~~ on TV promote patriarchal mind set and women in weaker role.

Its content further precipitate crimes. It must modify such themes and promote awareness against ~~gendered~~ crimes. It should display women in powerful role that inspire their female viewers.

## Awareness through educational institutions:

Educational institutions have important role in promoting awareness about women rights, laws ~~for~~ the protection against crimes. There should held weekly and monthly seminars to spread awareness. moreover,

education syllabus should be designed to educate women about their protection, laws and their enforcement universities must establish centres for the protection of students against harassment.

## Effective and rapid response from Criminal Justice System:

The criminal justice system of Pakistan has, unfortunately, failed to promote gender-equality and prevention of gender violence. Due to which large numbers of gendered crimes remained unregistered. It must be reformed to ensure effective investigation and delivery of justice to victims. There should be proper guidelines, training, funding and using new technological method to end gendered-crimes.

For the purpose of forensic investigation of crimes. Scientific techniques are used by forensic experts in forensic laboratories.


### Forensic experts:

Forensic experts acquired the specialization in forensic Science. They investigate evidence related to crime by visiting crime site as in the laboratories using the evidence brought by Police.


They also contribute as + in testimony in the court and

# Handles faced to <sup>forensic</sup> criminal investigation in Pakistan



## Lack of training:

The first major hurdle in criminal investigation using forensic methods is the lack of training in the specified area. There are few institutions across the country that are providing training, as a result it has not been developed on a firm basis.

## Shortage of forensic experts:

Another major hurdle is the shortage of forensic experts in the country, which has reduced the investigative value of this area. There is no much awareness about acquiring diplomas in this area. Additionally, there are few incentives which don't attract the youth towards this field.

## <sup>forensic</sup> Lack of Laboratories:

Another hurdle is the lack of forensic laboratories in the Pakistan. There is one laboratory in Lahore, Karachi and Peshawar. No laboratories have been established in major cities, which shows the inefficiency of the relevant stakeholders and affect the criminal proceedings.

## Lack of research in forensic Science:

Lack of research in the area of forensic Science is a major hurdle in the forensic investigation in Pakistan - As there are few universities offering this Forensic Science program and no university offers PhD in this area which reduce chances of research to improve the field.

Lack of funding for the forensic  
criminal investigation:

Another problem is the  
lack of provision of funds to  
aid the forensic investigation of  
crimes. As result of negligence of  
government towards this area deprive  
it of modernization of tools and  
technology to enhance the effectiveness  
of investigation.

Recommendation to overcome  
problems in forensic investigation

Government must establish a  
separate unit in the investigative  
branch that work on the  
upgradation and evaluation of  
the forensic area of investigation  
Funding for the advancement  
of the area should be

described to enhance the forensic expertise and usage of technology. Collaboration with other states for the transfer of forensic tools and relevant technology along with training of experts. Universities must be required to conduct and ~~publish~~ research in this area.

## Conclusion:

Forensic criminal investigation is the fundamental part of investigative procedure. However, in Pakistan this area is producing less effective results in investigation due to negligence of government towards this area. Government must provide the funding, establish forensic science laboratories in all major cities to aid the criminal investigation.

Introduction:



states and violation of international law.


### Youth crime definition:
